Butler raised this subject, recalling that, when he and Mr. Rusk had called on Sir Alec Douglas-Home the previous evening, he had suggested that the Prime Minister write President Johnson about it. Rusk said this created no problem. The President wanted this to be handled through direct personal contact between the Prime Minister and himself. It was a good idea to start with a letter. The problem could then be discussed in Washington in February. Meanwhile it would be understood that the understanding which had existed between President Kennedy and Prime Minister Macmillan would continue. Butler said this was very satisfactory.
