## MEMORANDUM

SPS - Mr. Polyzoides To:

Please add to your memorandum for the record for Park on today's flap on the testimony bearing on Japanese peace feelers, that I outlined in detail the problem to Bill Jackson in the absence of General Smith, and pointed out that if the Secretary were further queried, he might be forced into a statement of inability to disclose further information and that obviously the Department would want the consultation and backing of General Smith as Chairman of USCIB, if not of USCIB itself.
