The materials we seek include all memoranda, correspondence, articles, reports, etc. The time period covered is December 1990 to the present.

As we are a public research institute, we ask that you waive any applicable fees. Release of the information is in the public interest because it will contribute significantly to public understanding of government operations and activities.

If my request is denied in whole or in part, I ask that you justify all deletions by reference to specific exemptions of the act. I will also expect you to release all segregable portions to appeal your exempt material. I, of course, reserve the right to appeal your decision to withhold any information or to deny a waiver of fees.

I look forward to your reply within ten business days, as the statute requires.
