MEMORANDUM FOR THE DIRECTOR OF CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE

Subject: George Folk Murder

1. On 25 May 1948 one [redacted] of [redacted] Athens, informed me of that he had a chance meeting on 24 May 1948 with a Communist who said she had witnessed the Folk murder. The alleged witness, a [redacted] has been known to informant for approximately two years, and ostensibly acts as a Communist courier between Athens and Salonica. Informant was unable to ascertain the whereabouts of this witness, and he cannot now be located by [redacted] to clarify or add to the above information.

2. [redacted] believe the above information to be dubious and that it comes as a result of informant's interest in a reward offered by the Greek Government.
