SITREP COVERING PERIOD 140600 JUN TO 141800B JUN 94.

- 1. GEN SITUATION. THE DAY PASSED RATHER QUIETLY IN KIGALI WITH LESS OF HOSTILITIES BETWEEN TWO FACTIONS. HARASSING FIRE HOWEVER CONTINUED BETWEEN THE RGF AND RPF PROM THEIR RESPECTIVE POSITIONS IN KIGALI. THERE WERE NO MAJOR CHANGES IN THE DISPOSITIONS OF THE TWO WARRING FACTIONS IN KIGALI AND AS WELL NORTH OF THE COUNTRY. GITARAMA IN THE SOUTH IS NOW UNDER FULL CONTROL OF RPF. HIGH INFLUX OF REFUGEES WERE REPORTED IN CYANGUGU FROM GITARAMA AND BUTARE, MILITIA AND INTERHAMME CONTINUE TO MAN SOME ROAD BLOCKS AND CHECK POINTS IN RGF CONTROLLED AREAS IN THE CITY. THE EXERCISE ON TRANSFER OF DISPLACED PERSONS WERE SUBFENDED DUE TO SECURITY REASON. BETWEEN 1400 HRS TO 1500 HRS INTERHAMME / MILITIA HAVE TAKEN AWAY 40 CHILDREN AGED BETWEEN 13 TO 18 YRARS FROM ST PAUL TO AN UNKNOWN DESTINATION. INVESTIGATION BY MILOES ON THIS ISSUE CONDUCTED BUT MILITIA DID NOT ALLOW THEM TO INVESTIGATE, HOWEVER FURTHER INVESTIGATION WILL BE MADE TOMORROW. SEVENTH TRIPARTITE CEASE FIRE MEETING WAS HELD AT FORCE HO UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF THE DFC. THE MEETING ENDED WITH OUT ANY SIGNIFICANT PROGRESS. THE NEXT MEETING WILL BE HELD ON 16 JUNE 94.
- 2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES NOTHING TO REPORT.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

- A. RPF. AFTER CAPTURING GITARAMA, RPF IS NOW IN MUCH BETTER POSITION. THEY CONTINUED TO FUT PRESSURE ON THE RGF POCKETS LEFT IN THE CITY BY CONSTANT HARASSING FIRE, MORALE OF RPF SEEM TO BE VERY HIGH AND APPEARS TO BE MORE CONFIDENT TO TAKE RGF POSITIONS ONE AFTER ANOTHER.
- B. RGF. AFTER LOSING GITARAMA, RGF MAY FIND IT DIFFICULT TO HOLD KIGALI. THEIR MORALE SEEM TO BE ABSOLUTELY SHATTERED. IT IS ALSO REPORTED THAT RGF ARE RUNNING SERIOUS SHORTAGE OF AMMUNITION AND FUEL THOUGH THEY ARE CONTINUING TO RETALIATE RPF FIRE TO DEFEND THEIR POSITIONS WITHIN KIGALI CITY. INFORMATION ALSO REVEALED THAT THERE COULD BE A SERIOUS COMMAND SET BACK IN RGF ANY TIME IN KIGALI.
- C. MILITIA. CONTINUE TO MAN SOME CHECK POINTS IN RGP CONTROLLED AREAS IN THE CITY.

4. ONE KILITARY ACTIVITIES

A. FORCE ED. NORMAL ROUTINE WORKS WERE CONDUCTED. STAFF BRIEFING WAS CONDUCTED BY THE DFC AT 0700 HRS. DFC CHAIRED THE SEVENTH ROUND OF CEASE FIRE TALKS. THE MEETING ENDED WITHOUT ANY SIGNIFICANT PROGRESS. THE NEXT MEETING IS BCHEDULED ON 16 JUNE 94. OPERATION ON TRANSFERRING DISPLACED PERSONS WERE SUSPENDED TODAY DUE TO SECURITY REASON.

- B. UNCHUR: AREA OF OPERATION IS CALM. ROUTINE PATROLS WERE CARRIED OUT IN AOR. 46 VEHICLES CROSSED THE BORDER INTO RWANDA WITH 406 PASSENGERS INCLUDING 309 REPUGEES. 60 VEHICLES CROSSED INTO UGANDA WITH 252 PASSENGERS. ON 13 JUNE IN CYANIKA BORDER CROSSING POINT, RPF DID NOT ALLOW RWANDESE TO CROSS UGANDA. IT WAS THE FIRST TIME THAT IT HAPPENED AFTER THE RPF HAVE TAKEN OVER THE CONTROL OF THE AREA. TWO HELICOPTERS ARE PRESENTLY OPERATIONAL.
- C. AYURAT. CONTINUED TO PROVIDE SECURITY AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM AND FORCE HQ. PROVIDED PROTECTION AND HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE: TO DISPLACED PEOPLE AT KIA AND AMAHORO STADIUM, PROVIDED ESCORTS TO RGF DELEGATION WHO CAME FOR THE CRASE FIRE CONFERENCE, UNIT MEDICAL OFFICER TREATED 25 DISPLACED PERSONS FROM KIA AND AMAHORO STADIUM.
- D. TUN PLATOCH (+). AREA OF OPERATION WAS RELATIVELY CALM: PROVIDED SECURITY AND HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE TO DISPLACED PERSONS AT MILLIE COLLINS HOTEL, MERIDIEN HOTEL AND KING PAISAL HOSPITAL. ALSO CARRIED OUT ESCORT DUTIES WITH APCS.
- MILON: MILON TRAMS WERE EMPLOYED FOR THE FOL DUTIES DURING: THE PERIOD:
 - (1) MONITORING ACTIVITIES AROUND DISPLACED PERSONS CAMPS AT ST PAUL CHURCH.
 - (2) TWO TEAMS: WENT TO KAGITUMBA TO ESCORT MSP AND UNAMIR PERSONNEL ARRIVING THROUGH ENTERBY PROM NAIROBI TO KIGALI.
 - (3) TWO TRAMS ESCORTED OFFICIALS OF WPP, RED CROSS AND OFFICIALS OF MEDICINES SANS FRONTIERS.
 - (4) TWO TEAMS ESCORTED THE RGF REPRESENTATIVES TO PEACE TALK MEETING.
 - (5) RPF SECTOR MILOES CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS IN THEIR SECTOR.
- 5. DECIVIOL. SIX ARRIVED AT KIGALI SO FAR AND NINE ARE STILL IN NATROBI.
- 6. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES THE TRANSFER OF DISPLACED PERSONS WERE SUSPENDED TODAY. MILITIA DID NOT ALLOW THE EVACUATION OF REFUGERS. UNICEF CARRIED OUT VACCINATION CAMPAIGN AT AMAHORO STADIUM: UNICEF ISSUED THREE BASIC MEDICAL KITS TO THE ICRC HOSPITAL. AHT DELIVERED 100 BOXES OF BISCUITS TO TANZANIAN EMBASSY, 108 BOXES TO HOTEL MILLIES COLLINES AND 38 BOXES TO ST MICHEL ORPHANAGE. ICRC TREATED 21 PATIENTS IN THEIR HOSPITAL. IN CYANGUGU PREFECTURE ICRC DELIVERED 26 TONS OF FOOD. THEY ALSO DELIVERED 75 TONS OF FOOD IN RUTARE. 9000 LTRS OF WATER WERE DELIVERED TO NYANZA HOSPITAL.
