SITREP COVERING PERIOD 301800B JUNE TO 010600B JULY 94.

- 1. GEN SITUATION. THE NIGHT WAS GENERALLY CALM UNTIL THE EARLY HOURS OF THIS MORNING WHEN EXCHANGES OF ARTY/MORTAR, EMG AND SAS RESUMED IN AND AROUND KYCHIRU CAMP, NYAMIRAMEO, KIMIHURURA AND THE CITY CENTER. THE RPF CONTINUED TO EXERT MORE PRESSURE ON RGF POSITIONS WITH THE RGF RETALIATING WITH SIMILAR TYPE WEAPONS. THE ACTIVITIES OF THE MILITIA AND INTERHAMME ARE STILL ON THE INCREASE. THE SUPPLIES OF FOOD ITEMS SEEM TO BE RUNNING LOW IN SOME PARTS OF KIGALI DUE TO THE ROUTES BEING CUT OFF BY THE RPF. SOME MEMBERS OF THE CANADIAN RECCE TEAM LEFT THIS MORNING FOR NAIROBI VIA ENTERBES. THE OFERATIONS OF THE FRENCH CONTINUE IN THE WESTERN PART OF THE COUNTRY: THE FC WILL BE RETURNING TO KIGALI LATER THIS AFTERNOON THROUGH KABALE AND MULINDI WHERE HE WILL BE PRESENTING MEDALS TO UNOMUR UNMOS AND UNAMIR UNMOS RESPECTIVELY.
- 2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. THE POLITICAL SITUATION IN NEIGHBORING BURUNDI CONTINUES TO DETERIORATE. PRESIDENT MUSEVENI OF UGANDA HAS BEEN QUOTED AS SAYING THAT THE SOLUTION TO THE RWANDESE PROBLEM LIES WITH THE RWANDESE THEMSELVES.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

- A. RPE. RPF CONTINUED TO FRESSURIZE AND ISOLATE RGF POSITIONS WITH ARTY/MORTAR, HMG AND SAM PIRM. EXCHANGES RESUMED THIS MORNING IN NYAMIRAMBO, KYCHIRU CAMP, KIMIHURURA AND CITY CENTER. NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGES HAVE BEEN REPORTED FROM THE NORTH AND SCUTH OF THE COUNTRY. REINFORCEMENTS ARE STILL POURING INTO KIGALI FROM THE NORTH.
- B. RGP. THE RGP CONTINUED TO BE IN DEFENCE DURING THE PERIOD. THEY RETALIATED TO RPF FIRES WITH MORTARS, HMG AND SAE FIRE FROM THEIR POSITIONS IN KYCHIRU, KIMIHURURA, NYAMIRAMBO AND THE CITY CENTER.
- C. MILITIA. CONTINUE TO CONTROL ROAD BLOCKS AND CHECK POINTS. THEIR ACTIVITIES REMAIN VIOLENT IN RGP CONTROLLED AREAS. THEY ARE REPORTED TO BE RESISTING FRENCH TROOPS ATTEMPTS TO EVACUATE PEOPLE IN DANGER IN THE AREA SOUTH OF KIBUYE.

4. ONE MILITARY ACTIVITIES:

A. FORCE BO. NORMAL ROUTINE STAFF WORK WAS CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD. THE NORMAL STAFF BRIEF WAS CONDUCTED BY THE DFC AT 1900 HRS. PREPARATIONS AND PLANNING FOR UNAMIR EXPANDED FORCE CONTINUED. BIGHT MEMBERS OF THE CANADIAN RECCE DEPARTED THIS LOCATION FOR NAIROBI THROUGH ENTERBH. THE FC WILL RETURN TO KIGALI LATER IN THE DAY PROM MULINDI.

- B. UNONUE. AREA OF OPERATIONS REMAINED CALM. CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS. NOTHING SIGNIFICANT TO REPORT.
- C. GEAMATT. AREA AROUND KIA WAS CALM. PROVIDED SECURITY AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM AND FORCE HQ. PROTECTED DISPLACED PERSONS AT AMAHORO STADIUM AND KIA, ALSO CONTINUED TO PROVIDE HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE TO DISPLACED PEOPLE AT AMAHORO STADIUM AND KIA. CONDUCTED PATROLS WITHIN KIA GENERAL AREA AND ALONG RUNWAY FROM 2200 HRS TO 2250 HRS AND FROM 0430 HRS TO 0500 HRS.
- D. TIM PL. ARRA REMAINED CALM. PROVIDED SECURITY AT KING FAISAL AND HOTEL MERIDIEN TO DISPLACED PERSONS.
- R. MILOR. TWO TEAMS LEFT THIS MORNING FOR KAGITUMBA WITH PERSONNEL PROCEEDING TO NAIROPI. TWO TEAMS LEFT FOR MULINDI TO ESCORT THE FC ON HIS RETURN TRIP TO KIGALI.
- 5. UNCLYPOL. ALL ARE IN NAIROBI.
- 6. HUMANITARIAM ACTIVITIES: ARRANGEMENTS ARE BEING MADE TO OBTAIN A TRUCE TO FACILITATE THE SMOOTH TRANSFER OF PATIENTS AND THE SUPPLY OF RELIEF AID TO DISPLACED PROPLE WITHIN THE CITY.
