I have listened very carefully to your statements this morning generally concerning the state of our negotiations and specifically your reaction to the very constructive proposals put forward by President Carter yesterday. I must frankly tell you that I am disappointed. Your response ignores the very great effort of President Carter to meet your concerns while providing equal security for both sides. I hope and expect that you will study and your colleagues in Moscow will study carefully what President Carter said to you yesterday.

2) I will <sup>not</sup> attempt to comment on all of the matters which are unresolved. The fact that I have not commented on a particular issue and this should not be taken as any indication of agreement with the Soviet position. Furthermore, I want to make crystal clear that agreement on ~~of~~ each specific issue is conditional on agreement on all the issues.
