- MISSION HAS BEEN INFORMED THAT CONTACTS HAVE ALREADY TAKEN PLACE BETWEEN THE TAEA AND CHINA AND THE IAEA AND ALGERIA. CHINESE REPRESENTATIVE PROVIDED

SECRETARIAT WITH REMARKS OF THE SPOKESMAN OF CHINESE FOREIGN MINISTRY ON NUCLEAR REACTOR IN ALGERIA OF APRIL 30, 1991. TEXT IS SET FORTH IN PARA 5 BELOW.

SINCE CHINA JOINED THE INTERNATIONAL ATOMIC ENERGY AGENCY IN 1984, WE HAVE HADE AGGEPTANCE OF TAEA SAFEGUARDS AND SUPERVISION ONE OF THE PRECONDITIONS FOR OUR NUCLEAR EXPORT. ACCORDING TO OUR INFORMATION, THE ALGERIAN SIDE WILL BRIEF LAEA ON THE NUCLEAR COOPERATION BETWEEN CHINA AND ALGERIA AND DISCUSS WITH IT THE ISSUE OF SUBMITTING THE REACTOR TO LAEA

CHINA'S NUCLEAR EXPORT IS STRICTLY GUIDED BY ITS POLICY OF NUCLEAR NON-PROLIFERATION. CHINA DOES NOT STAND FOR, OR ENCOURAGE, OR ITSELF ENGAGE IN NUCLEAR PROLIFERATION, NOR DOES IT HELP OTHER COUNTRIES TO DEVELOP NUCLEAR WEAPONS. THERE ARE THREE PRINCIPLES

GUIDING CHINA'S NUCLEAR EXPORT; NAMELY, GUARANTEE FOR PEACEFUL USE, SUBMISSION TO IAEA SAFEGUARDS AND SUPERVISION AND NON-TRANSFER TO THIRD COUNTRY, END TEXT. NEVLIN

THE COOPERATION BETWEEN CHINA AND ALGERIA IN NUCLEAR FIELD IS ENTIRELY FOR PEACEFUL PURPOSES. IN FEBRUARY,

1983, CHINA AND ALGERIA SIGNED A PROTOCOL ON NUCLEAR COOPERATION, IN WHICH CHINA AGREED TO PROVIDE ALGERIA WITH A HEAVY WATER REACTOR FOR RESEARCH. THE POWER OF THE REACTOR IS VERY SHALL, WITH A DESIGNED POWER OF 18 MEGAWATT AND THE MAXIMUM THERMAL POWER OF 15 MEGAWATT.
