SUMMARY: (C/MF) DURING A VISIT TO MZ #18. SAN MARCOS. ON 850610, THE MZ COMMANDER, COL JORGE RENE ((ISAACS)) ROORIGUEZ, AND HIS OPERATIONS OFFICER 13-3) BRIEFED

BRIEFING AND SUBSEQUENT

CONVERSATIONS INCLUDED THE STATUS OF GUERRILLA OPERATIONS IN THE DEPARTMENT, MILITARY OPERATIONS THERE AND THE GOALS OF THE MZ IN SAN MARCOS.

1. ACCORDING TO THE S-3, THE INSURGENTS OPERATING
IN SAN MARCOS ARE MEMBERS OF THE REVOLUTIONARY
ORGANIZATION OF THE PEOPLE IN ARMS (ORPA) AND THEYHAVE TWO OPERATIONAL FRONTS IN THE DEPARTMENT. THE
NORTHERN FRONT, THE COMMANDANT MANUEL COMPANY
(COMPANIA DE COMMANDANTE MANUEL), HAS AN ESTIMATED
86 ACTIVISTS. THE SOUTHERN FRONT HAS APPROXIMATELY
BY LOCAL SYMPATHIZERS WHO ARE MEMBERS OF A POPULAR
RESISTANCE ORGANIZATION CALLED THE "RESISTENCIA
POPULAR DE COMPESIMOS". HO ESTIMATE WAS GIVEN
ABOUT THE RUMBER OF SYMPATHIZERS IN SAM MARCOS.

2. THE NORTHERN FRONT REPORTEDLY HAS WEAPONS THAT INCLUDE 72 M-16 RIFLES, 9 MISSILE LAUNCHERS (PROBABLY RPG-2'S), ONE 60 MM MORTAR, ONE HEAVY MACHINEGUN, AND ONE "CANNON". THE S-3 INDICATED THAT THERE IS NO EVIDENCE THAT THE GUERRILLAS HAVE A "CANNON" AND THAT THE BIGGEST WEAPON USED THERE TO DATE WAS A GOMM MORTAR.

IT IS VERY UNLIKELY THAT GUERRILLAS HAVE AN ARTILLERY PIECE BUT PROBABLY HAVE A GOMM MORTAR.)

3. TO DATE, THE GUERRILLAS HAVE BEEN MOST ACTIVE IN THE TAJAMULCO VOLCANO AREA. NEVERTHELESS, THE OFFICIALS IN SAN MARCOS ESTIMATE THAT, IN GENERAL TERMS, THE GUERRILLAS ARE ON THE WANE IN THE MORTHERN FRONT. ONE EXAMPLE CITED WAS THAT THE GUERRILLAS HAVE BEEN FORCED TO STEAL FOOD AND SUPPLIES WHEREAS BEFORE THEY BOUGHT SUPPLIES AT WELL ABOVE MARKET PRICES. ON THE OTHER HAND, THE ESTIMATE IS THAT PRICES. ON THE UTHER MANU, THE ESTIMATE IS THAT GUERRILLA STRENGTH IS INCREASING IN THE SOUTHERN FRONT; FURTHER SPECIFICS WERE NOT ADDRESSED.

4. A CONTINUING AREA OF CONCERN IN MZ #18, IS THE USE OF MEXICAN TERRITORY AS AN INSURGENT SAFEHAYEN.

MILITARY AUTHORITIES ARE CONVINCED THAT THE GUERRILLAS GAIN AT LEAST PASSIVE ACQUIESCENCE FROM MEXICAN AUTHORITIES, IF NOT OUTRIGHT SUPPORT. CURRENT INTELLIGENCE IN MZ #18 INDICATED THAT A GROUP OF GUERRILLAS (NFI) HAD BEEN SPOTTED IN TOJQUIAN CHICA BUT WHEN THE ARMY MOVED IN. THE GUERRILLAS HEADED TOWARD THE MX BORDER. REPORTEDLY, THE ARMY WAS ATTEMPTING TO BLOCK THE GUERRILLAS' ESCAPE WITH AMBUSHES PLACED NEAR THE BORDER ALONG SUSPECTED TRAILS. THE MZ COMMANDER REALIZED THAT HE WILL HAVE A DIFFICULT TIME ELIMINATING THE INSURGENCY SO LONG AS HX TERRITORY PROVIDES AN OUTLET FOR THE GUERRILLAS.
5. OPERATIONS IN MZ #18 INCLUDE COMBAT PATROLS. SOCIO-ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OF THE INFRASTRUCTURE, PSYCHOLOGICAL OPERATIONS, AND TRAINING. ACCORDING TO THE S-3. THERE HAVE BEEN 21 CONTACTS WITH INSURGENTS IN THE PERIOD JAN-JUN 85. GUERRILLA CASUALTIES ASSESSED FOR THAT PERIOD WERE REPORTEDLY 5 KILLED AND 23 WOUNDED. DEVELOPMENTAL PROJECTS

HZ #18, SAN MARCOS SUBJECT: IIR DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE, WHICH IS HEADED BY THE MZ COMMANDER AT THE DEPARTMENT LEVEL. TRAINING IS BEING CONDUCTED BY ONE OF THE TWO DETACHMENTS LOCATED NEAR IOJOUIAN GRANDE AND IS REPORTEDLY COMMENTS: (CANE) THE BRIEFING AND CONVERSATIONS WERE CONDUCTED IN A VERY FRIENDLY AND OPEN ATHOSPHERE. THE ATTITUDE OF THE COMMANDER AND S-3 IN MZ #18

VERY PROFESSIONAL AND GUARDEDLY OPTIMISTIC. THEY SEEMED TO HAVE A SHAKY UPPER HAND AT THE MOMENT. READING BETWEEN THE LINES, HOWEVER, THE HOLD IS TENUOUS. WITHOUT SUFFICIENT RESOURCES TO ACCELERATE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND INTERGRATION, THE ARMY WILL HAVE & VERY DIFFICULT TIME STABILIZING THE DEPARTMENT AND ENHANCING POPULAR SUPPORT FOR THE GOVERNMENT. THE PROXIMITY OF SAFEHAVENS IN MEXICO FURTHER COMPLICATES THE PROBLEM OF STABILIZATION AND COUNTERINSURGENCY IN SAN MARCOS. THERE ARE JUST NOT ENOUGH TROOPS IN THE ZONE TO TOTALLY CONTROL THE AREA. UNITS ASSIGNED THERE SUFFER FROM DEFICIENCIES IN COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT AND FROM A DEARTH OF MOBILITY RESOURCES.
THE RUGGED SAN MARCOS TERRAIN MAKES HELICOPTERS THE ONLY RELIABLE HEARS OF MOVEMENT AND THE NATIONWIDE SHORTAGE OF HELICOPTERS IS WELL KNOWN. GIVEN RESOURCE LIMITATIONS IN GT IT IS UNLIKELY THAT STABILIZATION. EFFORTS IN SAN MARCOS WILL SIGNIFICANTLY IMPROVE IN THE NEAR FUTURE.
