Subject:

At your meeting today with Senator McGovern (attended by Messrs. Hollum, Dockery, Richardson, and myself), the Senator said:

-- although the Cuban baseball season is over he believes they could get together an all-star team;

-- from the standpoint of US baseball the event would have to be either mid-July or put off until next spring;

-- Castro is very enthusiastic about having an exhibition match.

You said:

-- you had been in touch with Bowie Kuhn about 4 months aco about a baseball team to Cuba but the idea did not work-out;

-- some time after Senator McGovern returned from Cuba, Kuhn got in touch with you to ask whether McGovern had opened the possibility again for a baseball team to Cuba;

-- you told Kuhn that the issue was still complicated by our overall policy toward Cuba;

-- Kuhn should draw up a scenario, including proposed personalities, timing, and publicity arrangements and you would see whether you could present the proposal to the Secretary;

-- matches in Cuba should be combined with a match in Santo Domingo for general foreign policy purposes;

He thought the idea of having the team also go to Santo Domingo was an excellent one. He was prepared to go along with your approach and to keep it confidential.
