Interrogation of subject by this agent in Camp
March 5 March 1947 and in the interrogation
of this office on 6 March 1947 (subject's removal
from Camp March 4. Orr for interrogation on 6 March
1947 authorized per FAX Message No. 6, dated
March 1947, from CIB to USPIC, and his return to the
camp on the same day at 1710 hours was reported to
CIB by FAX Message No. 7, dated 7 March 1947) determined
the following:

BURGER Anton, born 19 November 1911 in Neun-
kirchen, Land Niederoesterreich, graduate of a
business school in Neunkirchen in 1925, served
in the Austrian Bundesheer in Wiener Neustadt
from 1930 until 1933, attaining the rank of cor-
poral. He was discharged from the service on sus-
picion of sympathy with the NSDAP.

Following a period of unemployment from 1933
until 1935, during which time he disclaimed NSDAP
activities, subject became an SS-Bewerber in Vienna
in 1936 and was assigned for six weeks to the file
section of the SS office in Vienna, Rotzschlid
Gasse.

From October 1938 until July 1939 subject, still
an SS-Bewerber, worked in the "Zentralstelle fuer
juedische Auswanderung" in Vienna, issuing to
Jewish applicants their emigration documents which
had been processed by the "Zentralstelle". From Fall
1939 until summer 1940 subject was assigned to the
"Zentralstelle fuer die Regelung der Judenfrage
in Bessien und Buchren" in Prag, Czechoslovakia,
where he worked as an SS-Cberschreuer in the
Fall 1939. In Prag, subject's duties

Subject was promoted to Obersturmführer on 15 April 1940. He was assigned to the Verwaltungsstelle for Jewish property in Prague. He was in charge of the leasing (bookkeeping, renting) of real estate in the city of Prague formerly belonging to Jewish residents. During subject's period of duty the Verwaltungsstelle administered a total of five to eight hundred former Jewish houses. From 1941 until late in 1942, subject was in charge of the (Arbeits) office of the Judenrat in Prague, administering approximately twelve to fifteen hundred former Jewish houses in Prague. On 20 April 1941, he was promoted to an Obersturmführer in the SD.

Subject allegedly because of a disagreement with his superior, Hauptsturmführer GUINER was transferred to the "Zentralstelle" in Prague. He was ordered to report to the higher headquarters of the "Zentralstelle", Section IV B 4, Reichskommissariat in Berlin, headed by Hauptsturmführer EICHMANN and Obersturmführer WOLFF. Subject's duties during his assignment to Section IV B 4 in Berlin from the end of 1942 until June 1943 included frequent trips to a courier to Vienna, Prague, and the concentration camp Mauthausen, delivering "secrete Reichsmittel" (secret Reich matters) to the SD offices in these places. Subject disclosed knowledge of the contacts of these "secret Reich matters".

On instructions from EICHMANN, in June 1943 subject replaced Obersturmführer SEIDL as commanding officer of the concentration camp Mauthausen, where removal was ordered by the Reich Commissioner in the part of the camp. Subject believed SEIDL was sentenced to death by the Volksgericht in Vienna (1943). EICHMANN advised subject that the Mauthausen "secrete" must become "ein Vorbild" (a model camp for inspection) of the camps in the Reich and the Sudetenland.

Subject stated that, because of a reprisal against "Karl Haas, Commanding Officer of the 'Kriegsgefangene' in Prague and as such Subject's superior in Theresienstadt, for failure to report the theft of a considerable quantity of cigarettes from the camp warehouse and for granting permission to a Jewish camp inmate to write a letter to his wife, Subject was ordered back to Berlin in March 1944 and from there assigned by SICHAHN to the DAS office, under SS-Standartenfuhrer F. J. W. (alter name below) in Athens, with the understanding that this was his chance to rehabilitate himself. Subject was succeeded in Theresienstadt by SS-Obersturmfuhrer KARL Kroll (arrested).

In Athens subject replaced SS-Obersturmfuhrer [Name] (fug), (several personalities with this name appear in "List of SS-Officers;" one appears on "ID" card No. 28,094 as an SS-Hauptsturmfuhrer in 1944, head of the department dealing with Jewish affairs under DAS Athens for one month after March 1944). Subject admits that, under his orders, the remnants of Athens' Jewry, approximately six to eight hundred persons, were deported "in the direction of Vienna". Subject stated that he had reported their departure by FAX to Berlin and he received further instructions as to their disposition were issued later by the NSDA in Berlin.

From July 1944 until October 1944, subject was under medical treatment for a heart condition in [Location]. In October 1944, subject was ordered by SICHAHN to join the "Sonderstab".

Subject stated that, during interrogations, he had denied membership in the SS and had explained his blood mark as a blood donor's mark. He said that he had never been fully interrogated by American investigators. He had had to remain unrecognized until his American departure. For this reason, he had denied his membership in the SS when first interrogated by this agent on 5 March 1947 and even during the first part of the second interrogation on 6 March 1947.

Subject named the following SS-personalities assigned to the concentration camp Theresienstadt during his period of service:

It is recommended that Subject's case be brought to the attention of CIC 7709 in Calzburg and that he be transferred from Compound V to the War Crimes Compound at Camp Marcus A. Orr.

It is further recommended that Subject's wife, (Name), be investigated by CIC Camp Oberosterreich, with a view to determining her part in Subject's activities and the extent to which she profited by his activities at (Name), as well as to develop new leads on the whereabouts of RICHMANN and/or members of his staff.

It is submitted that the belated and almost accidental discovery of Subject in Camp Marcus A. Orr points to the probability of the presence of other, hitherto undetected war criminals in internment camps.
