BUENOS AIRES (ARGENTINA), OCT. 17 (REUTERS) - DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN ARGENTINA AND ISRAEL WILL BE RESUMED AFTER A FOUR-MONTH BREAK FOLLOWING THE EXECUTION LAST MAY OF ALLEGED NAZI MURDERER ADOLF EICHMANN, THE FOREIGN MINISTRY ANNOUNCED TODAY.

ARGENTINA WITHDREW ITS AMBASSADOR TO ISRAEL AND EXPELLED THE ISRAELI AMBASSADOR AFTER ISRAELI AGENTS ABDUCTED EICHMANN FROM ARGENTINA AND TOOK HIM TO ISRAEL TO STAND TRIAL FOR RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE NAZI WARTIME MURDER OF MILLIONS OF JEWS.

THE FOREIGN MINISTRY SAID ROGELIO TRISTANY WILL BE APPOINTED ARGENTINE AMBASSADOR IN TEL AVIV. JOSEF AVIRAL, FORMER DIRECTOR OF THE ISRAELI LABOR OFFICE, WILL BE ISRAEL'S ENVOY TO ARGENTINA.
