Reference is made to the suggestion made by a representative of the Federal Bureau during a conversation with [redacted] of this Agency, concerning the Argentine Government's belief that Subject may be identical with Adolf KICHMANN. It was suggested that the Argentine Government provide more explicit information on Subject so that the Bureau could compare such identification with information in its files to determine whether or not he is identical with KICHMANN.

2. Forwarded herewith are fingerprints of Subject, provided by the Argentine Government. This Agency would appreciate receiving the results of the Bureau's comparison of these prints with information on KICHMANN in its files.
