1. CONFIDENTIAL - ENTIRE TEXT
2. Ambassador, accompanied by Johnstone and Glassman, called on Dr. Suazo morning June 16.
3. Among other subjects, matter of Saazo visit to US was discussed. Suazo said he would be pleased to accept invitation for official working visit and that proposed July 14 date was acceptable.
4. Suazo indicated that he would be interested in staying in Washington for two days rather than one so as to have sufficient time for meetings with international organizations as well.
5. It was agreed that ^{with} Suazo's positive reply to the July 14 date we would now ask Washington for additional details including a proposed schedule for GOH consideration
