1. SECRET - ENVIRE TEXT.

SUMMARY. IN AN APPARENT TROOP ROTATION, A MAJOR TROOP CONVOY HEADED WEST THIS MORNING OUT OF THE CITY. FIRING SHOTS AS IT WENT, THE CONVOY HIT SEVERAL APARTMENTS IN THE JIANGUOMENWAI DIPLOMATIC COMPOUND WITH AUTOMATIC WEAPONS FIRE. IN THE BARLY

AFTERNOON, TROOPS SEALED OFF THE DIPLOMATIC COMPOUND IN ORDER TO CAPTURE A SUSPECTED SNIPER WHO HAD FLED THERE. AN EMBASSY CONVOY PICKED UP 55 AMERICANS TODAY PROM THE UNIVERSITY AREA AND DELIVERED THEM TO THE AIRPORT. THE SITUATION IN CHENGDU WAS CALM AS OF 1400 HOURS LOCAL, BUT THE CONSULATE GENERAL HAS ADVISED AMERICANS THERE TO LEAVE CHINA AND MOST HAVE RESERVATIONS FOR PLIGHTS OUT THIS WEEK. END SUMMARY.

SHOOTING IN THE JIANGUOMENWAI AKEA

3. AT ABOUT 1000 HOURS LOCAL AS THE AMBASSADOR WAS CONVENING A GENERAL STAFF MEETING REGARDING EVACUATION PLANS, POLMILOFF WEST OF THE JIANGUO HOTEL OBSERVED TROOPS MOVING EAST FROM THE DIRECTION OF TIANANMEN SQUARE TOWARD THE HOTEL IN THE JIANGUOMENWAI AREA. SOLDIERS IN THE FIRST FIVE OR SIX TRUCKS IN THE CONVOY SHOUTED SLOGANS SUCH AS: "PROTECT THE PEOPLE; PROTECT THE STUDENTS; UNITY IS STRENGTH." SHORTLY THEREAFTER, TROOPS IN TRUCKS AS FAR BACK AS THE CITIC BUILDING OPENED FIRE. THE SHOTS APPEARED TO BE AIMED AT OR ABOVE ROOFTOPS, BUT SOLDIERS LOWERED THEIR SIGHTS (BUT DID NOT FIRE) AT ANY SPECTATORS WHO DID NOT COWER IMMEDIATELY BEHIND SECRET

NEARBY PROTECTIVE COVER. THERE WERE SOME 70 TROOP TRUCKS WITH APPROXIMATELY 25 SOLDIERS IN EACH TRUCK, ONE PETROLEUM TRUCK, AND FOUR OR FIVE SUPPLY TROLLEYS. TWO HELICOPTERS FLEW OVERHEAD.

4. WHEN THE CONVOY HAD PASSED THROUGH THE AREA, ONE PEDESTRIAN SAID THE UNIT WAS FROM SHENYANG AND THAT THEY HAD BEEN IN THE SQUARE ON THE NIGHT OF JUNE 3-4. AT AROUND 1015, POLOFF IN THE JIANQUOMENWAL DIPLOMATIC COMPOUND HAD OBSERVED THE SAME CONVOY PASSING OVER THE JIANGUOMENWAL OVERPASS. HEAVY AUTOMATIC WEAPONS FIRE, APPARENTLY AIMED IN THE AIR, WAS HEARD COMING BOTH FROM THE CONVOY BUT ALSO FROM GUANGHUA LU TO THE MORTH. EMBOFFS REPORTED BULLETS SHATTERED THE WINDOWS OF MANY APARTMENTS IN THE JIANGUOMENWAL DIPLOMATIC COMPOUND, INCLUDING IN THREE APARTMENTS BELONGING TO EXBASSY OFPICERS.

PROVIDED DAG WITH A POSSIBLE EXPLANATION OF THE DEPARTING CONVOY.

ACCORDING TO THE JOURNALIST, THE 20TH GROUP ARMY UNIT ARRIVED JUNE 6 TO REPLACE THE MUCH-HATED 27TH GROUP ARMY UNIT, WHICH IS LARGELY HELD TO HAVE BEEN RESPONSIBLE FOR THE TIANANMEN SQUARE INCIDENT. THE TROOP ROTATION IS APPARENTLY INTENDED TO IMPROVE

RELATIONS BETWEEN THE MILITARY AND THE RESIDENTS OF THE CITY. WE HAVE NO CONFIRMATION OF THIS REPORT.

6. AT APPROXIMATELY 1800 HOURS LOCAL, PMBOFF OBSERVED THE 18 TANKS POSITIONED ON THE JIANGUOMENWAI OVERPASS DEPART TOWARD TIANAMEN SQUARE, LEAVING THE OVERPASS INTERSECTION CLEAR FOR THE PIRST TIME IN DAYS. AS OF 1900 HOURS LOCAL, IT WAS NOT KNOWN WHETHER THE INTERSECTION WOULD REMAIN CLEAR, OR REPLACEMENTS WERE ON THE WAY.

TROOPS ENCIRCLE DIPLOMATIC COMPOUND

- 7. AT APPROXIMATELY 1200 HOURS LOCAL, TROOPS BEGAN MOVING INTO THE VICINITY OF THE JIANGUOMENWAI DIPLOMATIC COMPOUND. THEIR MOVEMENTS SUGGESTED THEY MIGHT BE CONDUCTING A SEARCH. AS THE TROOPS BEGAN TO ENCIRCLE THE COMPOUND, A NUMBER OF RUMORS BEGAN TO SURFACE, INCLUDING A REPORT THAT APARTMENTS WERE BEING LOOTED.
- 8. THE EMBASSY RSO, ACCOMPANIED BY SEVERAL MARINES, ORGANIZED A NUMBER OF VANS TO REMOVE USG EMPLOYEES AND THEIR DEPENDENTS FROM THE COMPOUND. AT APPROXIMATELY 1330 HOURS LOCAL, THE TROOPS SHUT THE GATES OF THE COMPOUND LOCKING IN 24 USG EMPLOYEES AND DEPENDENTS AND MANY OTHER POREIGN RESIDENTS OF THE COMPOUND.
- 9. AT 1510 HOURS LOCAL, POLOFF REPORTED FROM INSIDE JIANGUOMENWAI THAT THE TROOPS WERE DRAGGING SOMEONE OUT OF THE COMPOUND AND THAT IT HAD BEEN ANNOUNCED THAT THE TROOPS WOULD SOON REOPEN THE GATES AND DEPART. THEY DID SO ABOUT FIVE MINUTES LATER.
- 10. BASED ON OUR AND OTHERS' TALKS WITH THE TROOPS, THE INCIDENT MAY HAVE BUSUN WHEN A SNIPER FIRED SHOTS AT TROOPS FROM THE CITIC BUILDING, WHICH IS ACROSS THE STREET FROM THE DIPLOMATIC COMPOUND. THE SNIPER FLED TO JIANGUOMENWAI AND THE TROOPS ENCIRCLED THE COMPOUND IN ORDER TO ENSURE HE DID NOT SECRET

11. AS REPORTED SEPTEL, IN AN AFTERNOON MEETING WITH VICE FOREIGN MINISTER ZHU, AMBASSADOR LILLEY RAISED THE ISSUE OF PROTECTING AMERICAN CITIZENS IN CHINA AND MFA PACILITATION FOR THE LANDING OF EVACUATION AIRCRAFT IN CHINA. IN ANOTHER MEETING WITH EMBOFFS (SEPTEL), CHINESE AIRLINE AUTHORITIES INDICATED THAT THERE WOULD BE NO PROBLEM WITH LANDING RIGHTS FOR EVACUATION AIRCRAFT.

12. A CONVOY OF SIX VANS AND ONE CAR DEPARTED

EMBASSY AT ABOUT 0930 HOURS FOR THE UNIVERSITY AREA. THE CONVOY PICKED UP 55 AMERICAN TEACHERS, STUDENTS, AND DEPENDENTS FROM THE AREA AT THE FRIENDSHIP HOTEL AND THE BELJING NORMAL COLLEGE. THE CONVOY THEN DEPARTED DIRECTLY FOR THE AIRPORT, ARRIVING AROUND NOON.

13. ON THE THIRD RING ROAD AT AROUND 1000 HOURS, EMBOPPS IN THE CONVOY OBSERVED SIX MINISTRY OF PUBLIC SECURITY TRUCKS HEADING NORTH. EACH TRUCK CARRIED FIVE HELMETED PERSONNEL WITH ASSAULT RIPLES. EMBOPPS PARTICIPATING IN CONVOYS TO UNIVERSITY AREA HAD NOT PREVIOUSLY OBSERVED ANY ARMED PERSONNEL IN THE NORTHWEST BEIJING AREA.
