

SUBJECT: SITUATION IN EAST TIMOR

1. SUMMARY: ACCORDING SENIOR INDONESIAN GENERAL, GO CURRENTLY ARRANGING SELECTION EAST TIMOR ASSEMBLY AS PRELUDE TO PETITION FOR INCORPORATION INTO INDONESIA. CONTACT HAS BEEN OPENED BETWEEN PGET AND PORTUGUESE GOVERNMENT POSSIBLY LEADING TO RELEASE 23 PORTUGUESE MILITARY. GOI LEAVING TO PGET QUESTION OF INVITATION TO UN. END SUMMARY.

2. IN CONVERSATION WITH ME MAY 12
OUTLINED IN STRICT CONFIDENCE
CURRENT EFFORTS CHOOSE ASSEMBLY AND WORK OUT POLITICAL AND
INTERNATIONAL PROBLEMS.
3. CURRENT INDONESIAN EFFORTS LARGELY DIRECTED TO SELECTION
OF PROVINCIAL ASSEMBLY WHICH HOPEFULLY BY END MAY WILL BE
IN POSITION PETITION FOR INCORPORATION INTO INDONESIA.
EXPLAINED THAT ASSEMBLY WOULD BE COMPLSED OF
REPRESENTATIVES FROM 13 COUNTIES (KABUPATENS). IN EIGHT
OF THE COUNTIES CHOICES ARE BEING MADE BY ASSEMBLY OF
PEOPLE AND DELEGATES WILL PROBABLY INCLUDE LOCAL RAJA
PLUS TWO OR THREE OTHERS. IN THESE COUNTIES FEELS

POPULATION. FOUR COUNTIES IN INTERIOR REPRESENT THOSE FROM WHICH PORTUGUESE RECRUITED SOLDIERS AND BOTH BY GEOGRAPHY AND INCLINATION REMAIN FRETELIN STRONGHOLDS. BECAUSE POPULATION CONSISTS TO LARGE EXTENT OF RELATIVES OF SOLDIERS WHO FORMER BACKBONE OF FRETELIN, SELECTION PROCESS IN THESE COUNTIES CANNOT BE NORMAL. GOI WILL IN EFFECT NEED TO CHOOSE FROM OUTSIDE REPRESENTATIVES THESE FOUR COUNTIES. THIRTEENTH COUNTY BETWEEN DILI AND INDONESIAN BORDER HAS BEEN ISOLATED IN HOPES FRETELIN FORCES WOULD DRIFT TOWARD AREA IN WHICH SOME FORM OF NEGOTIATION WITH THEM MIGHT BE POSSIBLE. 7. WITHIN LAST FEW WEEKS PGET IN NEW YORK HAS HAD CONTACT WITH TWO DIFFERENT PURTUGUESE GROUPS. ONE WAS OFFICIAL DELEGATION LED BY PINTO AND SECOND WAS UNOFFICIAL DELEGATION LED BY TOMAS, PORTUGUESE WRITER. LATTER INCLUDED WIFE OF ONE OF 23 MILITARY STILL HELD IN TIMOR AND BROTHER-IN-LAW OF PGET LEADER, MARIO CARRASCALAO. INTENTION OF LATTER DELEGATION WAS TO PROVIDE FREER FORUM FOR DISCUSSIONS THAN OFFICIAL DELEGATION COULD UNDERTAKE. DISCUSSIONS WITH OFFICIAL DELEGATION WAS LARGELY PRO FORMA BUT TOMAS DELEGATION MADE PROGRESS ON DETAILS.

PORTUGUESE INTEREST WAS LARGELY IN
OBTAINING RELEASE OF 23 MILITARY PRISONERS. PGET REPRESENTATIVES EXPLAINED THAT THEY WANTED GOOD RELATIONS WITH
PORTUGUAL BUT THAT THEY FACED SERIOUS FINANCIAL PROBLEM,
PARTICULARLY DURING PERIOD UNTIL INCORPORATION INTO INDONESIA
COULD BE COMPLETED AND PROVINCE COULD RECEIVE REGULAR
BUDGETARY ALLOCATION FROM GOI. FOR THIS REASON, RELEASE
OF FUNDS ALLOCATED TO EAST TIMOR BY GOP AND STILL BEING
HELD IN BANK WAS IMPORTANT. TOMAS REPORTEDLY SAID THAT
IF THIS WAS ONLY PROBLEM, SOMETHING COULD BE WORKED OUT
BUT HE WOULD HAVE TO CHECK WITH PORTUGUESE GOVERNMENT
(PRESUMABLY PRESIDENT). TOMAS HAS NOW WRITTEN PGET

ADMITTED FRANKLY THAT INDONESIA HAD NOT WANTED RELEASE 23 SOLDIERS BECAUSE OF WHAT THEY MIGHT SAY ABOUT INDONESIAN INTERVENTION. AS FAR AS HE WAS CONCERNED, THIS PROBLEM LARGELY PAST AND HE WOULD PERSONALLY FAVOR PERMITTING PGET TO RELEASE SOLDIERS PROVIDED PGET RECEIVED SATISFACTION ON PORTUGUESE FINANCIAL HELP. HE ESTIMATED PORTUGAL MAY HAVE AS MUCH AS \$60 MILLION UNSPENT FROM PRIOR BUDGET ALLOCATIONS FOR EAST TIMOR. IF GOT CLEARANCE WITHIN GOI, SOLDIERS COULD BE RELEASE BEFORE AUGUST.

SAID SOLDIERS STILL UNDER INDONESIAN CONTROL.
THEY ARE GIVEN SPECIAL FOOD AND ARE WELL CARED FOR ALTHOUGH
SOME ARE SUFFERING FROM SKIN DISEASES. BECAUSE MOST OF
