SUBJECT: INFORMATION: Deputies Committee on Iraq, June 12, 2003

There are three items on the agenda for this meeting:

- Media Plan Update (DoD). Continuation of June 10 discussion on "Iraq Media Network: A Way Ahead."
- MEK Update (DoD). CENTCOM has 4,456 Mojahedin-e Khalq personnel assembled in a cantonment in Ashraf. After some delays, they are now being screened to determine who should be held or paroled. Information concerning views of MEK leaders on continuing role in Iraq. [REDACTED]
- PKK/Kadek Policy (DoD). This is guidance from OSD to the Joint Staff and CENTCOM for elimination of PKK/Kadek presence in Iraq. Discussion of options for achieving this goal. Attached draft has Grossman's edits but has not yet been approved by Department of Defense representative. [REDACTED]

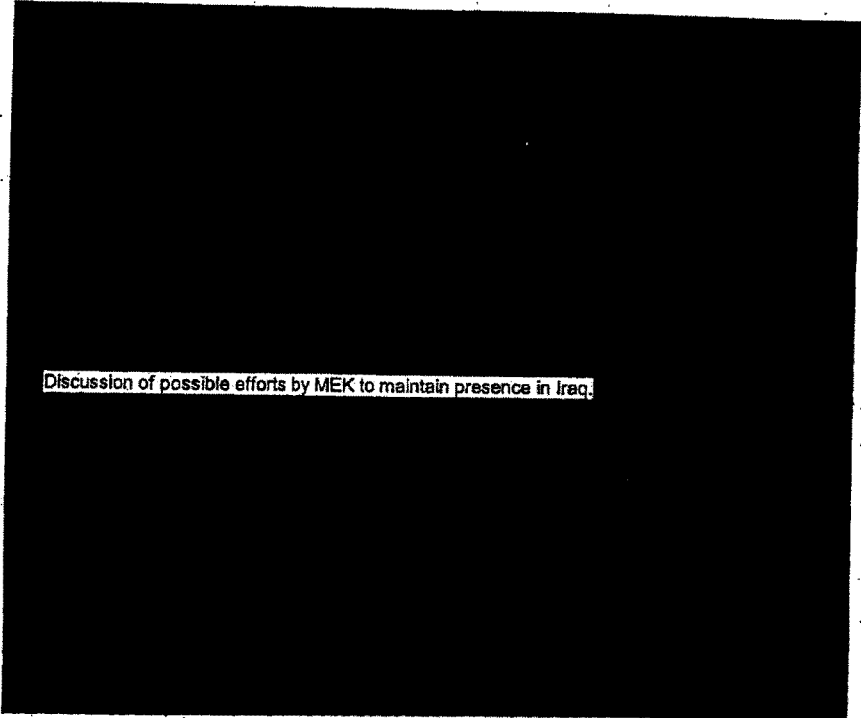
