

7. Letters of Commendation

(L) Two letters of commendation were received today. One for Mr. [redacted] and one for Mr. [redacted]. Both were signed by Les Dirks, Deputy Director for Science and Technology. He thanks them for their recent contribution toward the solution of important intelligence problems and states that they have demonstrated the importance and value of working jointly with other offices in our organization.

8. Providing KH-4 Material to EPA

(S) In a speed letter to NPIC EXO, [redacted] has stated that during the 1968-1971 time period NPIC provided to the Federal Preparedness Agency KH-4 contact paper prints, contact positive transparencies and geographic plots on WAG charts. The material had been returned to NPIC. We have no use for it and since a great deal of time has been put into this project, Mr. [redacted] inquired about the community to see if anyone had a need for it. Mr. Vernard Webb, Director, EPA Environmental Photographic Interpretation Center, believes it would make an excellent historical data base for studies that he is conducting. Mr. [redacted] informs us that he plans to send the material to [redacted] Security Officer, [redacted] where EPA has a facility in which to view the classified material.

9. Performance Evaluation -

(L) We received from Chief, Training Branch through Chief, Support Staff the overall outstanding performance evaluation on [redacted]. There was a note from [redacted] stating that [redacted] had applied for positions in the Office of Personnel and although she is an outstanding Training and Incentive Awards Assistant she has no headroom and cannot be promoted in the Training Branch at this time. She has recently received a QSI.

10. Reporting
