MEMORANDUM FOR MR. COLBY, DCI

SUBJECT: Defense Support Program Mission Classification

Your memorandum of December 15 (10855-73) asked for withdrawal of the Air Force proposal for public release of the Defense Support Program mission statement and avoidance of any other declassification of that program. In response to your request, Deputy Secretary of Defense Clements has asked Dr. McLucas and me to develop a paper which addresses the problems associated with using overt space programs to obscure the mission of NRO programs. He has also asked that this be presented for ExCom review and that further action of issuing a declassified mission statement for the Defense Support Program be deferred until the ExCom has addressed the issue.

Brigadier General John E. Kulpa, Jr. is the NRO Staff point of contact for addressing this item. Your inputs are needed and I would appreciate your designating someone to work with General Kulpa.
