Horman v. U.S.

1. This confirms our telephone conversation of 11 November 1977 in which you were advised that Stephen Cowen, the Justice Department attorney handling the above case, has scheduled an appointment with me on 22 November 1977 at 9:00 a.m. Mr. Cowen has requested the meeting to: a) [REDACTED]

b) [REDACTED]

c) review all pertinent Agency files on this matter. (Mr. Cowen understands that he cannot retain copies of any documents.)

2. As I told you in our conversation, I think that it would be to the Agency's advantage to be as candid and forthcoming as possible with Mr. Cowen, especially in light of CIA's apparent non-involvement in the substance of the law suit [REDACTED]. I have already secured an appropriate clearance for Mr. Cowen from the Office of Security.

3. Accordingly, it would be greatly appreciated if you or some other appropriate DO official could be available on 22 November at 9:00 a.m. In the meantime, please gather all relevant Directorate documents on Charles Horman and/or this law suit so that we may review them together prior to meeting with Mr. Cowen. I have levied a similar request on the Office of Security.
