
MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHAIRMAN, JOINT CHIEFS OF STAFF

Subject: Review of Necessity to Continue Holding
MSTS Passenger Ships in Port for CINCLANT
OPLAN 316-62

1. Five Military Sea Transport Service (MSTS) passenger ships are currently being held in New York port. One other ship will arrive and will be held in port 7 November 1962, and one on 8 November 1962. This is in accordance with CNO message 282219Z October 62 to COMSTS.

2. Costs of holding these ships are approximately \$10,000 per day for each ship.

3. Consideration should be given to the necessity for continuing to hold these ships in port in view of current circumstances.
