

10. Represent the Director for Operations as the OJCS primary point of contact for CIA for matters relating to psychological operations.
11. Provide the focal point for a special channel within the Worldwide Communications System involving the Services, the unified and specified commands, and selected component and subordinate commands in the area of psychological operations.
12. Monitor and make recommendations concerning force readiness of psychological operations forces, both Active and Reserve Components.
13. Monitor and make recommendations concerning the psychological operations training policies and exercises within the purview of the Joint Chiefs of Staff.
14. Maintain the Office of Record for all OJCS psychological operations documents and records

SUPPORT ACTIVITIES BRANCH

Functions:

1. Represent the Director for Operations, OJCS, as the DOD point of contact with other Governmental agencies for required support including: personnel, training, logistics, and services.
2. Provide the focal point for a special channel within the Worldwide Communications System involving the Services, the unified and specified commands, and selected component and subordinate commands.
3. Provide staff support for the planning and direction of special operations and related actions in which the Department of Defense participates.
4. Maintain the Office of Record in the OJCS for all support activities documents.

SPECIAL PLANS BRANCH

Functions:

1. Provide guidance and instructions to appropriate agencies on the conduct of special planning (perception management) activities.
2. Serve as the JCS member and secretariat of inter-departmental special plans group and its designated working group.
