SUBJECT: Request for Detail of Intelligence Analyst (U)

(U) I know that my Deputy for Policy Support, Ken deGraffenreid, has talked with you and has been working with your staff to enhance the intelligence support to my office, especially on war-related issues.

(U) As a part of this effort, I have assigned a number of intelligence-related duties to my Policy Support office. In support of my responsibilities in the intelligence-intensive areas of the Defense Sensitive Support Program, the Defense Special Plans Program, the Special Access Program Control Office, and the International Security Programs directorate, I have established a small office within Policy Support to assist in preparing specific sensitive intelligence requirements. The National Security Agency has supplied an intelligence specialist for a one-year detail. I would like to request a one-year detail of a DIA analyst to support this effort. I am specifically requesting [redacted] who is currently assigned to the Interagency Damage Assessment Team for the Robert Hanssen case. [redacted] has previous experience providing intelligence support to policy levels as well as specific Foreign Denial and Deception analysis experience needed to support my requirements.
