SUBJECT: (U) Policy Evaluation Group (PCTEG)

- We are requesting your approval to establish a special studies group, to be referred to as the Policy Counter Terror Evaluation Group (PCTEG), to conduct an independent analysis of the Al-Qaida terrorist network.
- The PCTEG will be tasked to:
 - Study Al-Qaida's worldwide organization including its suppliers, its relations with States and with other terrorist organizations (and their suppliers).
 - Identify "chokepoints" of cooperation and coordination.
 - Identify vulnerabilities.
 - Recommend strategies to render the terrorist networks ineffective.
- The PCTEG will be jointly chaired by Bob Andrews and Bill Luti and staffed by selected Policy reps and DIA detailees. [redacted] will lead the effort at the working level.

RECOMMENDATION: (U) Approve the establishment of the Policy Counter Terror Evaluation Group and sign the letter to VADM Wilson at Tab A requesting DIA support.
