1. ~~(C)~~The Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA) has reviewed your request for three specific individuals to support the establishment of the Policy Counter Terrorism Evaluation Group (PCTEG). We are prepared to detail two of the three individuals immediately for a 90-day period. These individuals, (b)(3):10 USC §424 and (b)(3):10 USC §424 will serve with the PCTEG as U.S. Navy reservists.

2. (U) Due to mission needs, we are unable to offer (b)(3):10 USC §424 to the PCTEG. (b)(3):10 USC §424 returned to his DIA civilian job this week after an extended period with our Global War on Terrorism task force. His expertise is instrumental in the Joint Military Intelligence Training Center's efforts to field the Asymmetric Threat Analytical Methodologies pilot course. This course, which has been endorsed by the Military Intelligence Board, is scheduled for April 2002.
