

I. GEN SITUATION. CALM AND UNCHANGED.

II. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

A. POLITICAL. RWBY NOT YET INSTALLED. NEGOTIATIONS ONGOING.

B. MILITARY.

(1) RPF. INFORMATION RECEIVED FROM RWTRAT PTL REGARDING CAMPS OF RPF AT SQ - 2495, 2222, 2086 AND A COY STR AT SQ 1783, 1722.

(2) RPF. RPF OFFERS RETURNED BACK TO MWINDI AFTER ATTENDING THE US EMBASSY SEMINAR ON "THE ROLE OF THE MILITARY IN A DEMOCRACY".

III. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. HQS. DFC HOLD A MEETING WITH DEPUTY CHAIRMAN AND CO OF RPF AT CND ON 221500Z JAN 94. TEN (10) NEW UNMOS FROM AUSTRIA AND ONE (01) STAFF OFFER FROM BANGLADESH HAS ARRIVED IN THE MISSION AREA ON 22 JAN 94.

B. SECTORS.

(1) KIGALI. CONDUCTED VEHICLE AND FOOT PTL IN KIGALI CITY IN ORDER TO ENSURE KIGALI WEAPON SECURE AREA. ESTABLISHED 4 CHECK POINTS AT DIFFERENT PLACES IN KWSA. PROVIDED 3 URMO ESCORTS TO RPF AND 2 TO RGF. ALSO PROVIDED ONE ARMED ESCORT TO PRIME MINISTER AND 2 TO RPF PERSONNEL. SECURED THE LOCATION OF THE RPF BATTALION IN KIGALI CITY, THE PREMATURE, FORCE HQ AND SEC HQ AND PROVIDED SECURITY TO THE AIRPORT OF KIGALI. DURING THE NIGHT ASSURED PROTECTION FOR THE PRIME MINISTER, THE PRIME MINISTER DESIGNATE, THE PRESIDENT OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT AND FIVE OPPOSITION MINISTERS, AND TO THE RESIDENCE OF SRSG.

(2) EMZ. CONDUCTED PTL IN RUHENGURI, NTAUKA, KALINGORERA, RUMERA. PTL MEET LOCAL INHABITANCE OF VILLAGE MURUSA (A-7723) AND IT WAS REVEALED THAT MANY DISPLACED PERSONS RETURNED TO THEIR HOMES AT BUTARO IN RPF HELD TERRITORY. IT WAS ALSO REVEALED MANY PEOPLE ARE WAITING FOR THE NEXT RELIEF AID DISTRIBUTIONS AFTER WHICH THEY WILL ALSO RETURNED TO BUTARO. IT WAS GATHERED THAT THIS TREND WAS A RESULT OF EXHORTATION THROUGH RPF RADIO. RADIO MURUSA: CALLING ON ALL TO

RETURN HOME AND CULTIVATE THEIR FIRMS. ANOTHER PTL CARRIED OUT FROM RINTINGERE, NKUMBA, RUMOMBO, KIRAMBO, KACUNDURA, RUHANGA, NYAMUCALI. PTL INFORMED AT KACUNDURA THAT ON 20TH JAN AT ABOUT 1900 HOURS A HAND GRENADE WAS THREW BY MR NZDABONIMA SON OF MR MUKOHOZI NEAR THE HOUSE OF MR BIZIMANA. AS SUCH TWO PERSONS ARE SERIOUSLY INJURED AND THEY WERE TAKEN TO THE HOSPITAL IN NEMBA FOR TREATMENT.

C. MILOB. CONDUCTED ESCORT FOR RFP PERSONNEL FROM KIGALI TO MULUNDI.

D. UNOMUR. CONDUCTED ROUTINE PTL WITHIN CAR. AT KABALE THREE (03) PICKUPS CROSSED BORDER INTO RWANDA AT KASHEKYE ALL CARRYING FIVE (05) PASSENGERS EACH. AT KISORO EVERY THING AS PER SCHEDULED. NO CONFIRMATION/INFORMATION REGARDING REFUGEE WILL NOW EIGHTEEN (18) RFP TRUCKS CROSSED BORDER AT KATUNA AND GOING TO UGANDA. FIVE (05) VEHICLES OF ICRC CROSSED BORDER FROM RWANDA TO UGANDA AND ALSO CAME BACK FROM UGANDA. A TOTAL FORTY ONE (41) VEHICLES CROSSED BORDER AT FATUNA. OUT OF TWENTY SEVEN (27) VEHICLES CROSSED INTO RWANDA AND TEN (10) INTO UGANDA AT KASHEKE BORDER THREE (03) VEHICLES CROSSED INTO RWANDA AND ONE (01) VEHICLE INTO UGANDA. ALL VEHICLE CARRIED FOOD AND PERSONNEL LUGGAGE. NOTHING SIGNIFICANT WAS FOUND.
