Ż. REGARDS. SOLUTION IN THE CND COMPLEX THESE PEOPLE WILL BE SENT OUT AND PUT UNDER THE PROTECTION OF THE GENERALE WITH UNCIVPOL MONITORING.

B. SECTORS.

- KIGALI, COMD SEC KIGALI HAD A MEETING WITH THE HOME MINISTER OF EWANDA ABOUT THE PROHIBITION OF DEMONSTRATIONS ON WITH "N 1.5 KM FROM THE CND COMPOUND. CONDUCTED VEHICLE AND FOOT FIL IN KIGALI CITY IN ORDER TO ENSURE KIGALI WEAFON SECURE AREA. ESTABLISHED 6 CHECK POINTS AT DIFFERENT PLACES IN KWSA, PROVIDED 2 UNMO ESCORTS TO CENDARMERIE, 2 FOR RPE, 1 FOR HEFTIGER CAMP AND 1 TO TANZANIAN BORDER, ALSO PROVIDED ARMED ESCORTS FOR THE PRIME MINISTER, REF AND UNDE. SECURED THE LOCATION OF THE RFF BATTALION IN KIGALI CITY, THE PREMATURE, FORCE HO AND SEC HO AND PROVIDED SECURITY TO THE AIRPORT OF KIGALI, DURING THE NIGHT ASSURED PROTECTION FOR THE PRIME MINISTER, THE PRIME MINISTER DESIGNATE, THE PRESIDENT OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT AND FIVE OPPOSITION MINISTERS, AND TO THE RESIDENCE OF SRSG.
- RUHENGERI BECAUSE OF NOT BEING SERVED WITH BEANS IN THEIR MEALS. THE SUPPLIERS CLAIM THAT THEY HAVE NOT BEEN PAID FOR THEIR SERVICES SINCE A LONG TIME AND THEY REFUSE FURTHER SUFFLY. PROVIDED ESCORT TO LAAR FOR FOOD DISTRIBUTION AND MEDICAL CARE FOR CHILDREN AT RWANKURA AND GASTAA. ALSO MONITORED THE FOOD DISTRIBUTION FROM LCRC AT NYAMUGALI. AID WAS GIVEN TO 4.200 REFUGEES.
- C. MILOB, ESCORTED REF TO FROM MULINEI. ONE UNMO THAM WAS SENT TO THE TANZANIAN/EWANDAN BORDER FOR ESCORT OF APC/TRUCK CONVOY PROVIDER ES BALAAM, MEETING WAS HELD BETWEEN MILOB RGF PECCE TRAM AND G3 RGF. A PROGRAM WAS AGREED UPON TO START AN OFFICIAL RECCE OF THE RGF ZONE. RGF AGREED ALSO ON CO-LOCATION OF MILOB HQ AT RUHENGERI AND BUTARE.
- D. UNOMUR. THE SITUATION IN THE UNOMUR AREA IS CALM. UGANDA IS CHERVING LIBERATION DAY TODAY 26 JAN. IT SEEMS THAT LUBIRIZI/KASHEKYE AREA IS CONFIRMED AS A CROSSING POINT FOR REFUGEES. A GROUP OF REFUGEES, ABOUT 10 PEOPLE WITH APPROXIMATELY 200 COWS CHOSSED THE PORDER AT KASHEKYE TO RWANDA AT 251215 JAN 94. IT TAME DUT FROM DISCUSSION THAT THIS PEOPLE CAME FROM THE REFUGEE CAMP LOCATED AT MEARARA CARRYING PERMISSION CERTIFICATE FROM MEARARA AUTHORITY, ANOTHER GROUP OF 10 TO 15 REFUGEES CROSSED THE BORDER AROUND 15.00 HRS WITH APPROXIMATELY 100 TO 150 COWS AND WITH LOT OF LUGRAGES THROUGH LUBIRIZI AND KASHEKYE. NO INFO REGARDING THEIR LOCATION OF ORIGIN COULD CONFIRM. SPECIAL PTL WAS CONDUCTED TO FIND A PROPER PLACE FOR A SECOND REPEATER STATION FOR CUMMUNICATIONS IN THE UNDMUR AREA. TOTAL 6 VEHICLES CROSSED THE BORDER AT GATUNA. TWO OF

THEM CAME FROM UGANDA TO SWANDA WITH TWO PASSENGERS CARRYING SMALL QUANTITY OF MITODKE, 4 VEHICLES WITH 8 PASSENGERS CAME FROM RWANDA. THEY HAD NO BUGGAGE WITH THEM.

VII. LOGISTICS. A SECOND BATCH OF VEHICLES ARRIVED FROM DAR ES SALAAM. THEY ARE IN VERY BAD STATE AND LOTS OF THINGS ARE MISSING. APC/TRUCK CONVOY CROSSED TANZANIAN/RWANDAN BORDER AND IS EXPECTED TODAY AT KIGALI.
