GEN BITUATION: OBSERVED TO BE TENSE, ON 201430 FEB PATHE MDR PARTY HELD A POLITICAL MEETING AT NYAMBANBO STADIUM: PRIME MINISTER, PRIME MINISTER DESIGNATE AND 'BOD PERSONS: ATTENDED, SEVERAL ROAD BLOCKS WERE SET UP HOWEVER THE SITUATION WAS BROUGHT UNDER CONTROL BY GENDARMERIE WITH UNAMIR MONITORING AND ABSISTANCE.
