SITREP COVERING PERIOD 120600Z MAY TO 121800Z MAY 94.

1. GEN. SITUATION. PERIOD WAS RELATIVELY CALM. THE SITUATION HOWEVER REMAINS TENSE AND FLUID. THERE WERE EXCHANGES OF FIRE BETWEEN THE WARRING FACTIONS EARLY IN THE MORNING. THERE IS NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGE IN THE POSITIONS BEING HELD BY BOTH SIDES IN THE CITY. FIGHTING STILL GOING ON UP NORTH AND IN THE SOUTH. MR BERNARD KOUCHNER ARRIVED MISSION AREA ON A FACT FINDING MISSION. DFC ADDRESSED THE TROOPS AT KIA, KING FAISAL HOSPITAL AND AMAHORO STADIUM.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES. FIGHTING CONTINUES UP NORTH, IN THE SOUTH AND IN THE CITY.

B. UNCOMUR. AREA GENERALLY CALM. CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS IN AOR. NOTHING SIGNIFICANT TO REPORT.

C. BYUBAT. AREA RELATIVELY CALM.
