SITREP COVERING PERIOD 131800H MAY TO 140600H MAY 94.

1. GEN SITUATION. SITUATION REMAINS TENSE AND FLUID. BOTH SIDES CONTINUE TO EXCHANGE FIRE IN THE NORTH (AROUND CYHRU, NKUMBA AND RUHENGRI) AND IN THE SOUTH (AROUND BUGESHERA). FIRE WAS ALSO EXCHANGED ALL NIGHT IN THE CITY IN THE AREAS OF REMERA KICHYICIRU AND KIMIHIRURA. NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGES IN LINES HELD BY BOTH SIDES IN THE CITY. FC AND DFC HELD INFORMAL DISCUSSIONS WITH MR BERNARD KOUCHNER - FORMER FRENCH MINISTER OF HEALTH. SOME MORE DISCUSSIONS SCHEDULED FOR TODAY IN RESPECT OF HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES. WARRING FACTIONS CONTINUE TO EXCHANGE FIRE ALONG THEIR FRONT LINES.

B. RGE. CONTINUE TO ADOPT A DEFENSIVE POSTURE. RETURNED FIRE FROM RPF. NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGES IN LINE HELD. TRAINING OF YOUNG RECRUITS CONTINUE.
