SITREP COVERING PERIOD 030600Z JUNE TO 031800Z JUNE 94.

1. GEN SITUATION. THE DAY WAS COMPARATIVELY CALM DESPITE SOME OCCASIONAL EXCHANGE OF FIRE BETWEEN THE WARRING FACTIONS IN SOME PARTS OF THE CITY. AFTER TAKEN OVER KABGAYE, RPF CUT OFF GITARAMA FROM THREE SIDES WITH A VIEW TO ISOLATE THE TOWN. IN KIGALI CITY RPF HAVE CAPTURED ALL THE IMPORTANT GROUNDS AROUND THE CITY AND PUTTING CONSTANT PRESSURE ON RGF POSITIONS BY MORTAR/ARTY SHELLING. RGF ALSO RETALIATED. IT IS ALSO REPORTED THAT RGF IS RUNNING SHORTAGE OF AMMUNITION AND OTHER STORES. RGF IS VIRTUALLY UNDER SEIZURE IN KIGALI CITY. EXODUS OF TROOPS, CIVILIANS AND MILITIA TO THE SOUTH STILL CONTINUES. GENDARMERIE CONTINUE TO MAN ROAD BLOCKS IN RGF CONTROLLED AREAS IN CITY. RPF GAVE PERMISSION TO THE HUMANITARIAN AGENCIES TO BRING RELIEF ITEMS TO RWANDA BY ROAD FROM THE NORTH THROUGH RPF LINES. THE EXERCISE ON THE TRANSFERRING DISPLACED PERSONS FOR THE FOURTH DAY WAS CARRIED OUT SUCCESSFULLY BY SHIFTING 175 PERSONS FROM AMAHORO STADIUM AND 165 PERSONS FROM SAINT FAMILLE. THE OPERATION DISCONTINUED DUE TO FIRING ON THE DISPLACED PERSONS CONVOY AT GADDAFI CROSSING. THE EXERCISE WILL CONTINUE TOMORROW.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. SRSR IS NOW IN ETHIOPIA.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

A. RPF. RPF TIGHTENING THEIR GRIPS AROUND KIGALI BY PUTTING CONTINUES PRESSURE ON RGF POSITIONS IN KIGALI CITY BY SHELLING. CONTINUED INFILTRATING IN NYAMIRAMBO AND GIKONDO. ADVANCE WESTWARD IN THE SOUTH CONTINUES GRADUALLY. AFTER CAPTURING KABGAYE, THEY HAVE ENCIRCLED THE TOWN. THEY HAVE TAKEN OVER FULL CONTROL OF THE ROAD KIGALI-GITARAMA IN GENERAL AREA RUNDA.

B. RGF. STILL HOLDING KYCHIRU AND NYAMIRAMBO PARTIALLY. THE RGF HAVE THEIR MAIN CONCENTRATION IN KIMIHURURA. RGF CONTINUE TO RETALIATE RPF FIRES WITH LESS INTENSITY. THEY SEEM TO BE RUNNING SHORTAGE OF AMMUNITIONS THOUGH INFORMATION REVEALED THAT RGF HAVE RECEIVED SOME ARTY AMMUNITIONS. NO CHANGE IN THE POSITIONS HELD IN NORTH AND SOUTH WEST OF THE COUNTRY. NOW CONSOLIDATING AROUND GITARAMA FOR FUTURE BATTLE. EXODUS OF SOLDIERS TO THE SOUTH CONTINUES WHICH AFFECTING THEIR FIGHTING CAPABILITY FOR KIGALI BATTLE.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

A. FORCE HQ. NORMAL ROUTINE ACTIVITIES WERE CONDUCTED. FC HELD NORMAL BRIEFING WITH STAFFS AT 0700. EXCHANGE OF REFUGEE OPERATION WAS UNDER TAKEN IN THE MORNING AND CONTINUED TILL 1200 HRS. DFC MONITORED THE WHOLE EXERCISE

FROM GADDAYI CROSSING. CANADIAN RECCE TEAM LEFT RWANDA IN THE AFTERNOON.

B. DISCONE UNOMUR OPERATIONAL AREA IS CALM. CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS IN AOR. ACOMO HOLD THE WEEKLY CONFERENCE WITH THE AREA COMMANDERS AND STAFFS. DCMO VISITED MERAMA HILLS AND KAFUNZO. ON 03 JUNE 21 VEHICLES OF WFP AND 4 VEHICLES OF OTHER HUMANITARIAN AGENCIES CROSSED THE BORDER THROUGH KATUNA TO RWANDA WITH HUMANITARIAN AIDS. TOTAL 32 VEHICLES CROSSED THE BORDER AT KATUNA, KASHEKYE, KYANIKA AND MERAMA HILLS TO RWANDA WITH 189 PASSENGERS INCLUDING 152 REFUGEES. ANOTHER 48 VEHICLES CROSSED THE BORDER AT KATUNA, KHEKYE, KYANIKA AND MERAMA HILLS WITH 172 PASSENGERS. APPROXIMATELY 2000 RWANDESE CROSSED THE BORDER AT KYANIKA FOR WORKS AND MARKETING. THEY RETURNED ON THE SAME DAY. TWO HELICOPTERS ARE PRESENTLY OPERATIONAL.

C. EXUBAT CONDUCTED SECURITY DUTY AT KIA AND AMAHORO STADIUM AND PROVIDED ESCORTS FOR REFUGEE EXCHANGE OPERATION. THERE ARE ABOUT 4326 REFUGEES AT AMAHORO STADIUM AND 1300 DISPLACED PERSONS AT KIA. CO GHANA BATTALION HAVE RETURNED FROM NAIROBI.

D. THE PL PROVIDED SECURITY TO REFUGEES AT MILLES COLLINS, MERIDIEN HOTEL AND KING FAISAL HOSPITAL. ALSO CARRIED OUT ESCORT DUTIES WITH APCs.

E. MILOR MILOBs PARTICIPATED IN THE EXCHANGE OF DISPLACED PERSONS OPERATION. ONE MILOB TEAM CARRIED OUT PATROLLING AT KIDAHU, KYANIKA AND GITARE TO ASSES THE SITUATION OF DISPLACED PERSONS. ACCORDING TO RPF REFUGEE COORDINATOR, NO REFUGEE HAS ARRIVED SINCE 25 APRIL. RED CROSS AND MSP ARE OPERATING IN THOSE AREAS. TOTAL NO OF DISPLACED PERSONS ARE 51313.

5. UNCTVROL. 15 ARE STATIONED AT NAIROBI.

6. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. UNAMIR WAS SUCCESSFUL IN TRANSFERRING 174 DISPLACED PERSONS FROM AMAHORO AND 165 FROM SAINT-FAMILLE. HAC HAVE FINALIZED THE LIST OF DISPLACED PERSONS WHO WANT TO BE EVACUATED FROM SAINT FAMILLE. UN HA DELIVERED 203 BOXES OF HEB TO ST FAMILLE, 36 BOXES TO HOTEL MILLES COLLINES, 66 BOXES TO KIA AND 20 BOXES TO SISTERS OF CHARITY. THE MEDEVAC OF 31 CHILDREN WILL BE CARRIED OUT ON 04 JUNE 94 BY AFTERNOON FLIGHT TO PARIS. THE OPERATION WILL BE SPONSORED BY THE FRENCH GOVERNMENT AND MEDICINES DU MONDE.
