SITREP COVERING PERIOD 011800Z JUN TO 040600Z JUN 94.

1. GEN SITUATION. THE NIGHT WAS RELATIVELY CALM. THERE WERE SPORADIC EXCHANGES OF ARTY/MORTAR, HMG AND SA FIRE IN KIMIHURURA, GIKONDO NYAMIRAMBO AND THE CITY CENTRE. HEAVY FIGHTING WAS REPORTED AROUND THE GADDAFI CROSSING AND IN THE WESTERN PART OF THE CITY THIS MORNING. THE RPF IS STILL IN FULL CONTROL OF THE ROAD KIGALI - GITARAMA. NO CHANGE IN RGF POSITIONS IN THE NORTH AND EAST OF THE COUNTRY. RPF ADVANCE WESTWARDS IN THE SOUTH CONTINUES. GITARAMA IS NOW ISOLATED FROM THREE SIDES. EXODUS OF SOLDIERS, MILITIAS AND CIVILIANS TO THE SOUTH STILL CONTINUING. THE GENDARMERIE CONTINUES TO MAN ROAD BLOCKS AND CHECK POINTS IN RGF CONTROLLED AREAS LEFT IN THE CITY. EXERCISE TO MOVE DISPLACED PEOPLE TO SECURE AREAS HAS BEEN SUSPENDED DUE TO SECURITY PROBLEMS. FORCE COMMANDER WILL LATER IN THE DAY MEET THE COE OF THE GENDARMERIE. 5 X MORTAR BOMBS LANDED AROUND THE KIA ARRIVAL HALL DURING THE PERIOD. THE DFC LEAVES THIS MORNING FOR NAIROBI FOR DISCUSSIONS WITH A GHANAIAN GOVT DELEGATION ARRIVING THERE THIS AFTERNOON.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. THE SRSG IS NOW IN NAIROBI AND CONTINUING WITH HIS CONTACTS WITH COUNTRIES IN THE SUB REGION IN THE SEARCH FOR A POSSIBLE SOLUTION TO THE RWANDESE CRISIS.

3. FACIIONAL ACTIVITIES.

A. RPF. RPF CONTINUE TO ISOLATE AND TAKE A FIRMER GRIP ON RGF POSITIONS IN KIMIHURURA, NYAMIRAMBO AND THE CITY CENTRE WITH ARTY/MORTAR AND HMG FIRE. NOW ENCIRCLED GITARAMA AND HAVE FULL CONTROL OF KIGALI - GITARAMA ROAD AT RUMDA. EXCHANGED HEAVY FIRE WITH THE RGF AROUND THE GHADDAFI CROSSROADS FOR CONTROL OF THAT AREA. TROOPS SOUTH OF GITARAMA REORGANIZING FOR A POSSIBLE ASSAULT.

B. RGF. RGF CONTINUE TO RETALIATE TO RPF ARTY/MORTAR, HMG FIRE FROM KIMIHURURA, AND CITY CENTRE FROM RPF POSITIONS AT CND AND ALONG ROAD TO MERIDIEN HOTEL. SOLDIERS AND MILITIA CONTINUE TO MOVE TO SOUTH. OFFERING STIFF RESISTANCE FROM KIMIHURURA AND AREA SOUTH OF GHADDAFI JUNCTION.

C. MILITIA. VERY LITTLE PRESENCE NOW IN THE CITY. THE GREATER NUMBER HAS MOVED OUT OF THE CITY TO THE SOUTH.

4. OMN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

A. FORCE HQ. NORMAL ROUTINE WORKS WERE CONDUCTED. FC HELD NORMAL HIS BRIEFING TO STAFFS AT 031900 JUN 94. THE BRIEFING CENTERED AROUND THE CURRENT SECURITY SITUATION AND THE EXERCISE TO MOVE THE DISPLACED PEOPLE TO SAFER AREAS.

B. UNCOMD. AREA OF OPERATION IS CALM. NOTHING SIGNIFICANT TO REPORT.

C. RYBAT. PROVIDED SECURITY AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM AND FORCE HQ. PROVIDED HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE AT DISPLACED PEOPLE AT KIA AND AMAHORO STADIUM. 5 X MORTAR BOMBS LANDED NEAR CONTROL TOWER AND ARRIVAL TERMINAL. THERE WERE NO CASUALTIES. CONDUCTED PATROLS IN KIA GENERAL AREA AND ALONG THE RUNWAY AT 032200 TO 032300 JUN 94.

D. TOM PLATOON (+). PROVIDED SECURITY TO DISPLACED PEOPLE AT HOTEL MERIDIEN, HOTEL MILLES COLLINS AND KING FAISAL HOSPITAL. OBSERVED EXCHANGES OF ARTY/MORTAR, HMG FIRE BETWEEN WARRING FACTIONS AROUND KIMIHURURA, NYAMIRAMBO AND THE CITY CENTRE.

E. MILOR NTR.

5. UNCIWPOL. ALL 15 ARE STILL IN NAIROBI. THE ARRIVAL OF THE ADVANCE PARTY OF 5 STILL AWAITED.

6. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. TRANSFER OF DISPLACED PEOPLE TO SECURE AREAS HAS BEEN SUSPENDED DUE TO THE INSECURITY AND THE LACK OF GUARANTEED SECURITY FROM THE RPF. MORE HUMANITARIAN REQUIREMENTS IN TERMS OF FOOD, WATER, MEDICINE E.T.C ARE STILL IN GREAT DEMAND.
