SITREP COVERING PERIOD 080600B JUNE TO 081800B JUNE 94.

- 1. GEN SITUATION. THE DAY WAS RELATIVELY CALM. SPORADIC ARTY/MORTAR AND HMG FIRE: WAS EXCHANGED BETWEEN RPF AND RGF POSITIONS IN AND AROUND KIGALI CITY. HEAVY FIGHTING WAS REPORTED IN THE SUBURBS OF NYAMIRAMBO AND GATSATA. GENDARMERIE CONTINUE TO CONTROL ROAD BLOCKS AND CHECK POINTS WITHIN RGF CONTROLLED SECTORS IN THE CITY. SOME MILITIA AND INTERHAMME WERE OBSERVED TO BE MANNING SOME ROADBLOCKS ALONGSIDE THE GENDARMARIE. IN THE NORTH, FIGHTING WAS REPORTED TO BE CONTINUING IN RUHENGERI. IN THE SOUTH HEAVY FIGHTING WAS REPORTED ON THE OUTSKIRTS OF GITARAMA, RPF ADVANCE WESTWARDS SEEMS TO BE STALLING ON THE LINE GITARAMA-RUBONGO-NYANZA, THE RESUPPLY CONVOY FROM UGANDA ARRIVED AT 081730 JUNE 1994. HOWEVER, ONE VEHICLE WAS LEFT ON THE WAY DUE TO MECHANICAL FAULT. DFC AND CMO RETURNED TO KIGALI WITH THE SAME CONVOY. THE FC CHAIRED THE THIRD TRIPARTITE CEASE FIRE MEETING BETWEEN RGF AND RPF HELD AT THE FORCE HQ. MR JEAN CHRISTOPHE XCOTZ, A FRENCH JOURNALIST WITH CAPA WAS SHOT IN NYAMIRAMBO THIS AFTERNOON, HE WAS HIT IN THE RINGT THIGH AND WAS RUSHED TO THE ICRC HOSPITAL, KIGALI. HE WILL BE EVACUATED BY ROAD TO THE UGANDA BORDER TOMORROW AND THEN BY AIR TO ENTERBER.
- 2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. THE OAU MINISTERIAL MEETING IS DISCUSSING THE RWANDAN CRISIS IN TUNIS. RADIO RWANDA CONTINUES TO ACCUSE PRESIDENT MUSEVENI OF UGANDA FOR HELPING THE RPF. THE PREFECT OF KIGALI IS REPORTED TO HAVE URGED THE FOFULATION TO ARREST LOOTERS AND CONFISCATE THEIR BOOTY TO HELP THE COUNTRY FINANCIALLY IN THE WAR.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

- A. RPF. THE RPF SQUEEZE ON RGF POCKETS IN THE CITY CONTINUES. EXCHANGED INTENSE FIRE WITH THE RGP IN NYAMIRAMEO, KIMIHIRURA AND GATSATA. HEAVY CASUALTIES WERE REPORTED FROM BOTH SIDES. ALSO EXCHANGED FIRE ON THE OUTSKIRTS OF GITARAMA. EXCHANGED ARTY/MORTAR, HMG, AND SAB FIRE IN OTHER PARTS OF THE CITY. ALSO CONTINUED TO CONTAIN THE RGF IN THE NORTH AROUND RUHENGERI AND NKUMBA.
- B. RGP RGF CONTINUE TO REINFORCE THEIR POSITIONS IN KIMIHIRURA AND THE CITY CENTRE. EXCHANGED HEAVY FIRE WITH THE RPF AROUND GATEATA FOR CONTROL OF THE FUEL STORAGE DEPOT AND THAT PART OF THE ROAD LEADING TO BYUMBA. ALSO FOUGHT THE RPF FIRECELY IN NYAMIRAMBO. CONTINUED TO STRONGLY DEFEND GITARAMA IN THE SOUTH. BELIEVED TO BE CREATING A SUFFER ZONE ON THE LINE CYANGUGU-BUTARE-MUYAGA TO HALT ANY RPF ANDANCE PURTHER SOUTH.
- C. MILITIA. SOME PRESENCE CESERVED IN THE CITY MANNING CHECK POINTS, AN INDICATION OF THEIR RETURN TO KIGALI.

4. ONN KILITARY ACTIVITIES

A. FORCE NO. ROUTINE STAFF WORKS WERE CARRIED OUT DURING

THE PERIOD. THE NORMAL STAFF BRIEFING WAS CONDUCTED AT 0700 HRS. THE FC CHAIRED THE THIRD TRIPARTITE CEASE FIRE MEETING TODAY. DELIBERATIONS WERE QUITE FRUITFUL AND ENCOURAGING. THE MEETING CONTINUES TOMORROW, 9 JUN 94. DFC RETURNED FROM UGANDA THIS EVENING BY ROAD WITH THE RESUPPLY (FUEL) CONVOY.

- B. UNCOUR AREA OF OPERATION WAS QUIET. ROUTINE PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD. 54 VEHICLES CROSSED IN TO RWANDA FROM UGANDA WITH 373 PASSENGERE, 224 OF WHO WERE REFUGEES. 37 VEHICLES CROSSED WITH 149 PASSENGERE FROM RWANDA INTO UGANDA, APPROX 1,500 PEOPLE CROSSED THE BORDER AT CYANIKA TO WORK AND MARKETING AND RETURNED IN THE AFTERNOON. TWO HELICOPTERS ARE OPERATIONAL, ONE HELICOPTER ON REPAIRS IN ENTEBBE HAD THE ROTOR BLADE DAMAGED WHEN IT WAS BEING FIXED BACK, AFTER REPAIR/MAINTENANCE WORKE. 13 X NGOS CROSSED THE BORDER WITH RELIEF ITEMS INTO RWANDA DURING THE PERIOD.
- C. BYWEAT: PROVIDED SECURITY AND PROTECTION AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM AND FORCE HQ. ALSO PROVIDED ESCORTS AND HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE TO DISPLACED PERSONS AT KIA AND AMAHORO STADIUM. PROVIDED ESCORTS TO HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES AND OTHER TASKS.
- D. TUN PL PROVIDED SECURITY TO REFUGEES AT MILLES COLLINS, MERIDIEN HOTEL AND KING FAISAL HOSPITAL. ALSO CARRIED OUT ESCORT DUTIES WITH APCS.
- E. MILOR: ORGANIZATION, COORDINATION AND PLANNING OF MILOB ACTIVITIES WERE CARRIED OUT. CARRIED OUT SECURITY AND ROUTINE PATROLS DURING THE PERIOD. ESCORTED UNICEF OFFICIALS TO SOME REFUGEE CAMPS IN THE CITY. THE TEAM THAT WENT WITH RESUPPLY CONVOY TO KABALE, UGANDA RETURNED THIS EVENING.
- 5. DMCIVPOL. 15 ARE STILL STATIONED AT NAIROBI.
- 6. EURAMITARIAM ACTIVITIES: HAC TEAM VISIT TO ORPHANAGES IN NYAMIRAMBO AND PSF, RESULTED IN STE ANDRE ORPHANAGE BEING FIRED UPON. AN INITIAL RECCE OF THE PROPOSED UN REFUGEE CAMP WAS CONDUCTED BY THE HA TEAM. ICRC HOSPITAL HAD 21 IN PATIENTS AND 23 OUT PATIENTS. THEY ALSO DELIVERED 63 TONS OF FOOD TO KISARO AND A SHIPMENT OF FOOD FROM BUNJUMBURA TO BUKAVU FOR DELIVERY TO CYANGUGU. THE MOVEMENT OF THE ICRC HOSPITAL FROM KABGAYE TO NYANIA SHOULD BE COMPLETED TOMORROW. TRANSFER OF DISPLACED PERSONS TO SECURE AREAS IS STILL SUSPENDED DUE TO INSECURITY.

- 8. LOGISTICS. RESUPPLY CONVOY FROM KABALE ARRIVED AT 081730 JUNE 1994. ONE VEHICLE LEFT ON THE WAY DUE TO MECHANICAL FAULTS, WILL BE RECOVERED TOMORROW. FORCE RESERVE STOCK LEVEL IS AS FOLLOWS:
