SITREP COVERING PERIOD 201600Z JUN TO 210600Z JUN 94.

1. GEN SITUATION: THE NIGHT WAS RELATIVELY CALM. HOWEVER HARASSING EXCHANGE OF MORTAR, HMG AND SAs FIRE CONTINUED IN THE SUBURBS OF NYAMIRAMBO, KIMIHURURA AND THE PRESIDENTIAL GUARD POSITIONS LOCATED AT VILLAGE URUGWIRO/KYCHIRU AND THE CITY CENTER. RGF CONTINUED TO FIGHT BACK FROM THEIR POSITIONS WITHIN THE CITY. MILITIA AND INTERHAMWE CONTINUE TO CONTROL ROAD BLOCKS, CHECK POINTS AND FIGHTING ALONGSIDE THE RGF. NO SIGNIFICANT CHANGES IN THE DISPOSITIONS OF BOTH WARRING FACTIONS IN KIGALI AND IN THE NORTH AND SOUTH OF THE COUNTRY. THE EXERCISE ON THE TRANSFER OF DISPLACED PERSONS IS SUSPENDED FOR TODAY. TWO MILOB TEAMS LEFT THIS MORNING FOR KAGITUMBA WITH PERSONNEL PROCEEDING TO NAIROBI.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. THE RWANDESE INTERIM GOVT HAS EXPRESSED SATISFACTION WITH THE OUTCOME OF THE OAU RESOLUTION ON THE RWANDESE CRISIS FROM TUNIS. THE RPF CONTINUES TO ISSUE STATEMENT REJECTING THE PROPOSED FRENCH INTERVENTION IN RWANDA. IN NEIGHBORING BURUNDI MASS DEMONSTRATIONS ARE PLANNED FOR TODAY TO PROTEST AGAINST THE FRENCH INITIATIVE. THE SITUATION IS BEING MONITORED FROM HERE.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

A. RPF. RPF CONTINUED TO HARASS RGF POCKETS OF RESISTANCE WITH MORTARS, HMG AND SAs FIRE. MAIN AREAS OF FIGHTING WERE IN KIMIHURURA, NYAMIRAMBO, AROUND PRESIDENTIAL GUARD POSITIONS LOCATED AT VILLAGE URUGWIRO/KYCHIKIRU. RPF SEEMS TO BE GAINING SOME MORE GROUNDS WITHIN THE CITY. SPORADIC EXCHANGES WERE ALSO REPORTED FROM BUTARE IN THE SOUTH AND RUHENGERI IN THE NORTH. REINFORCEMENT IN KIGALI AND THE SOUTH CONTINUES.

B. RGF. RGF CONTINUED TO RETALIATE TO RPF FIRES WITH MORTARS AND HMG FIRE TO RPF POSITIONS LOCATED IN THE NORTH AND EAST OF KIGALI. THEY CONTINUE TO EXCHANGE MORTAR AND MACHINE GUN FIRE IN RUHENGERI AND IN BUTARE. PREPARATIONS FOR THE EXPECTED BATTLES FOR GISENYI AND BUTARE CONTINUE.

C. MILITIA. MILITIA AND INTERHAMWE CONTINUE TO MAN ROAD BLOCKS IN RGF SECTORS. THEY HAVE BEEN OBSERVED TO BE DRESSED LIKE THE REGULAR FORCES. ARMED GANGS CONTINUED TO THREATEN INNOCENT CIVILIANS AND CHILDREN IN CERTAIN PARTS OF THE CITY UNDER RGF CONTROL.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

A. FORCE HQ. NORMAL ROUTINE WAS CONDUCTED. NORMAL STAFF BRIEF BY FC WAS CONDUCTED AT 1900 HRS. STAFF PREPARATIONS FOR THE EXPANDED FORCE CONTINUES. THE BODY OF MAJOR M.J SOSA OF URUGUAY WILL BE SENT TO URUGUAY FROM NAIROBI TODAY.

THE COO IS REPRESENTING THE FC AT THE PRE-DEPARTURE CEREMONY IN NAIROBI. MR MEDELI OF FOD IS EXPECTED IN LATER TODAY VIA ENTEBBE. THE FIRST CONVOY OF APCs HAVE STILL NOT REACHED KIGALI.

B. INCOMBAT. AREA OF OPERATION REMAINS CALM. CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS. NOTHING SIGNIFICANT TO REPORT.

C. GHAMBATI. CONTINUED TO PROVIDE SECURITY AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM AND FORCE HQ. ALSO OFFERED PROTECTION TO DISPLACED CIVILIANS AT KIA AND AMAHORO STADIUM. CONDUCTED PATROLS WITHIN KIA GENERAL AREA AND ALONG RUNWAY FROM 2100 HRS TO 2200 HRS AND FROM 0410 HRS TO 0510 HRS.

D. TWO PLATOON (+). AREAS OF OPERATION WERE VERY TENSE DURING THE PERIOD. TWO ARTY SHELLS LANDED VERY CLOSE TO HOTEL MERIDIEN. THERE WERE NO CASUALTIES. CONTINUED TO PROVIDE SECURITY AT KING FAISAL HOSPITAL, HOTEL MERIDIEN AND HOTEL MILLES COLLINS.

E. MILOB. TWO TEAMS LEFT FOR KAGITUMBA WITH 9 PERSONS PROCEEDING TO NAIROBI. PLANNING AND PREPARATION FOR THE PHASE 1 DEPLOYMENT IS IN PROGRESS. RPF SECTOR MILOBS HAVE RECEIVED INFORMATION FROM THE KISARO ADMINISTRATOR'S OFFICE THAT A NEW DISPLACED PERSONS CAMP HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED AT RUMARI NEAR BYUMBA. THE EXACT NUMBER OF DISPLACED PERSONS COULD NOT BE ASCERTAINED. THE CMO PLANS TO MEET THE RGF COS TODAY.

5. ENCIVROL. REORGANIZATION AND THEIR EMPLOYMENT CONTINUES.
6. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. EXERCISE ON TRANSFER OF DISPLACED PERSONS IS SUSPENDED TODAY.
