SITREP COVERING PERIOD 281800Z JUNE TO 290600Z JUNE 94.

1. GEN. SITUATION. THE NIGHT WAS CALM. SPORADIC EXCHANGE OF ARTY/MORTAR, HMG AND SAB FIRE CONTINUED THROUGHOUT THE NIGHT. RPF CONTINUED TO ISOLATE AND SQUEEZE RGF POSITIONS IN KYCHIRU CAMP, VILLAGE URUGWIRO, KIMIHURURA AND CITY CENTER. RGF CONTINUED TO FIGHT BACK AND RETALIATED TO RPF FIRES IN GENERAL POSITIONS AROUND MERIDIEN HOTEL AND THE ROUND ABOUT. MILITIA ACTIVITIES ARE STILL ON THE INCREASE. NO REPORTS HAVE BEEN RECEIVED OF ANY CHANGES IN SITUATION AND DISPOSITIONS IN THE NORTH AND SOUTH OF THE COUNTRY. THE FRENCH TROOPS CONTINUED TO MAKE PROGRESS IN THE WESTERN SIDE OF THE COUNTRY AND RECEIVING MUCH SUPPORT IN THAT AREA. MR RICARDO MAZALAM, THE JOURNALIST FROM ASSOCIATED PRESS WHO WAS SHOT AT YESTERDAY WAS EVACUATED TODAY TO NAIROBI. THREE ARTICULATED TRUCKS ARRIVED FROM ENTEBBE LAST NIGHT WITH 3 X M-113 APCs. A RECCE TEAM FROM THE CANADIAN SIGNAL SQUADRON ARRIVED LAST NIGHT. DFC WILL LATER THIS MORNING VISIT MERIDIEN HOTEL AND KING FAISAL HOSPITAL WITH THE GHANAIAN DELEGATION.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. THE PROS AND CONS OF THE FRENCH PRESENCE IN RWANDA CONTINUE TO BE THE TOPIC OF DISCUSSION IN THE POLITICAL CIRCLES IN AND AROUND RWANDA.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

A. RPF. RPF CONTINUED TO ISOLATE AND HARASS RGF POSITIONS WITH SPORADIC ARTY/MORTAR, HMG AND SAB FIRE IN KIMIHURURA, NYAMIRAMBO, VILLAGE URUGWIRO AND THE CITY CENTER. THE BUILD UP OF FORCES IN THE CITY AND OTHER AREAS CONTINUES. NO CHANGES IN THE NORTH AND SOUTH OF THE COUNTRY HAVE BEEN REPORTED.

B. RGF. RGF CONTINUED TO RETALIATE WITH MORTARS, HMG AND SAB FIRE TO RPF POSITIONS IN THE NORTH - EAST OF THE CITY AND AROUND HOTEL MERIDIEN. THEY CONTINUE TO ASSIST THE FRENCH TROOPS IN THE WESTERN SIDE OF THE COUNTRY.

C. MILITIA. MILITIA AND INTERHAMWE ACTIVITIES CONTINUE TO INCREASE IN THE CITY. CONTINUED TO MAN ROAD BLOCKS IN KIGALI. IN THE WEST, IT IS REPORTED THAT THE FRENCH ARE ADVISING THEM TO CEASE MANNING ROAD BLOCKS.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES:

A. FORCE HQ. NORMAL ROUTINE STAFF WORK WAS CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD. THE NORMAL STAFF BRIEF WAS CONDUCTED BY THE DFC AT 1900 HRS. THE GHANAIAN DELEGATION CONTINUES THEIR VISIT TO OTHER AREAS OF KIGALI THIS MORNING. THE WOUNDED JOURNALIST, MR RICARDO MAZALAM IS BEING EVACUATED TODAY TO NAIROBI THROUGH ENTEBBE.

B. UNOMO. AREA OF OPERATIONS REMAINED CALM. CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS. NOTHING SIGNIFICANT TO REPORT.

C. GHAMBATI. AREA AROUND KIA WAS CALM. PROVIDED SECURITY AT KIA, AMAHORO STADIUM AND FORCE HQ. PROTECTED DISPLACED PERSONS AT AMAHORO STADIUM AND KIA. ALSO CONTINUED TO PROVIDE HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE TO DISPLACED PEOPLE AT AMAHORO STADIUM AND KIA. CONDUCTED PATROLS WITHIN KIA GENERAL AREA AND ALONG RUNWAY FROM 2315 HRS TO 0020 HRS AND FROM 0410 HRS TO 0500 HRS.

D. TUM PL. AREA OF OPERATION WAS TENSE DURING THE PERIOD. SA FIRE WAS DIRECTED AT MERIDIEN HOTEL. THERE WERE NO CASUALTIES. CONTINUED TO PROVIDE SECURITY AT KING FAISAL AND HOTEL MERIDIEN. PROVIDED HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE TO DISPLACED PEOPLE LOCATED IN THE SAME AREAS.

E. MILOR. CONTINUED TO MONITOR ACTIVITIES AT HOTEL MERIDIEN. A TEAM OF UNMO THIS MORNING ESCORTED THE WOUNDED JOURNALIST TO KAGITUMBA.

5. UNCIYFOL. ALL ARE IN NAIROBI.

6. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. CONSULTATIONS WILL CONTINUE THIS MORNING WITH RGF IN ORDER TO WORKOUT THE RESUMPTIONS OF THE TRANSFER OF DISPLACED PEOPLE TO SAFE AREAS.
