THERE INDICATED THAT CHINESE GUARDS ARE PAYING PARTICULAR INSTANCE, THEY WENT THROUGH THREE SMALL CONTAINERS OF DUCK FEATHERS. THE REASON - THEY THINK STUDENTS MAY BE SMUGGLED OUT OF CHINA IN CONTAINERS. COMMENTS: (U) EACH DAY EVERYONE SEEMS TO HAVE A NEW HORROR STORY ABOUT CHINA. THEY ARE BECOMING ALMOST AS NUMEROUS AS CAAC STORIES. ALTHOUGH MANY OF THEM SEEM TOTALLY UNREALISTIC, THE FACT THAT THEY CONTINUE TO CIRCULATE AND ARE BELIEVED CREATES A PSYCHOLOGICAL
