ALTHOUGH IT WAS SAID THAT THOSE WHO HAD BEEN ARRESTEE  WERE ONLY EX-CONVICTS WHO HELPED STIR-UP A PUBLIC DISTURBANCE, AND  THAT NO ORDINARY STUDENT DEMONSTRATORS HAD BEEN ARRESTED, ABOUT A  HALF DOZEN TAIWANESE STUDENTS (NFI) WITH NO CRIMINAL RECORDS HAD  ALSO BEEN ARRESTED.  3. THE PEOPLE DO NOT BELIEVE EVERYTHING THE AUTHORITIES TELL  THEM ABOUT THE INCIDENTS. HOWEVER, THE PEOPLE IN THE SMALL  VILLAGES AND REMOTE AREAS STILL TEND TO BELIEVE THAT THE TURMOIL IN  BEIJING WAS MERELY A RIOT CAUSED BY VILLAINS, AS PROPAGANDIZED BY  THE AUTHORITIES.  4. HE HAD A FEW CHINESE FRIENDS  LISTEN TO IT, AND INVITED THEM TO MAKE COMMENTS. THEY ALL REPLIED  THAT IT MIGHT BE A FABRICATION BY THE WEST.
