HEMORANDUM FOR THE DIRECTOR, JOINT STAFF

SUBJECT: SEASAT-A Synthetic Aperture Radar (U)

(S/MED) On 1 Merch 1976, the Joint Chiefs of Staff, in MJCS 64-76 refined In earlier (JCSH-219-75, 30 May 1975) position regarding the military utility of data from the synthetic aperture radar (SAR) to be flown aboard the MASA Ocean Bynamics Satellite, SMASAT-A. As a result of this position, MASA has indicated the following intentions with respect to management of the SAR:

- a. A device will be installed on the SAR command uplink which when activated will prevent unauthorized control of the SAR.
- b. Routine 24-hour-in-advance notification of the intended data acquisition program will be provided to DoD.
- c. Rader imagery will not be acquired routinely and repetitively over the entire United States land mass; some repetitive coverage over cropland, however, will be acquired for agricultural research.
- d. The SAR data sequisition network will include three United States ground stations (Alaska, California and Florida) and one Canadian station near St. Johns, Newfoundland. In addition, MASA has entered discussions with the European Space Agency for establishment of a station in England. Other future possible sites include Horway, Belgium, Australia and Japan although there are no specific programs for their establishment at this time. In all cases, MASA will retain control of the SAR programming and there would be no command control from any of the foreign stations.

Additionally, MASA would be provided copies of all SAR data upon request and SAR coverage would be limited in extent and for Rab, not routine operational coverage.

(U) With respect to item b above, MASA is now ready to proceed with planning for DoD notification and requests the name of a DoD contact with whom they can work to establish a mutually acceptable procedure. I believe Major R. J. Salewski, USAF, in the J-3 Directorate is familiar with this issue and with

Bixby, USH, Chairman, Joint Environmental Satellite Coordinating Group, as my representative.
