(C) IN WHAT APPEARS TO BE AN ORCHESTRATED CAMPAIGN OF ATTACKS ON SECTIONS OF THE PRESS IN PERU, A SERIES OF ARTICLES HAS BEEN APPEARING IN THE PAGES OF FOUR LIMA TABLOIDS ACCUSING SEVERAL JOURNALISTS OF TREASON FOR THEIR INVESTIGATIVE ARTICLES WRITTEN ON THE PERUVIAN ARMED FORCES AND INTELLIGENCE SERVICES. ON A DAILY BASIS SINCE MARCH 27, FOUR PERUVIAN JOURNALISTS (JOSE ARRIETA, ANGEL PAEZ, FERNANDO ROSPIGLIOSI, EDMUNDO CRUZ) AND ONE OWNER/DIRECTOR (GUSTAVO MOHME, WHO IS ALSO AN OPPOSITION CONGRESSMAN) HAVE BEEN THE SUBJECTS OF LENGTHY ARTICLES IN THE YELLOW PRESS, INCLUDING A BRAND-NEW PAPER, "EL TIO," WHICH STARTED RUNNING THE ARTICLES SHORTLY AFTER ITS INCEPTION. MOHME AND THREE OF THE JOURNALISTS WORK WITH THE STRONGLY OPPOSITION DAILY "LA REPUBLICA" AND THE OTHER, JOSE ARRIETA, IS THE FORMER CHIEF INVESTIGATIVE REPORTER FOR BARUCH IVCHER'S TELEVISION CHANNEL.

THE CATALOGUE OF OFFENSES AGAINST THESE JOURNALISTS INCLUDE THEIR REPORTING ON THE TELEPHONE TAPPING, THE CRASH OF A MIG-29, AND THE COLLAPSE AFTER 30 MINUTES OF A NEW BRIDGE REBUILT AFTER EL NINO DAMAGES. OVER THE COURSE OF THE MONTH THE TONE OF THE ARTICLES HAS BECOME MORE SHRILL, WITH THE APRIL 30 FULL-PAGE PIECE IN "EL TIO" ACCUSING ONE REPORTER, ANGEL PAEZ, THE HEAD OF LA REPUBLICA'S INVESTIGATIVE UNIT, OF BEING AN ECUADORIAN SPY.
