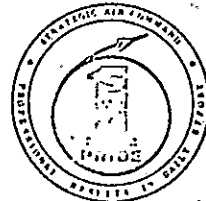

PART I. MAINTENANCE GENERATION

1. THIS MESSAGE IS IN ADDITION TO REFERENCED MESSAGES, SAME SUBJECT.

ALL UNITS EXCEPT 93BW, 34OBG, RECONNAISSANCE AND TANKER RECONNAISSANCE SUPPORT UNITS WILL COMMENCE GENERATION, AT A TIME SELECTED BY THE UNIT COMMANDER, OF ALL CATEGORY CHARLIE AND FOXTROT SORTIES FOR WHICH AIRCRAFT ARE AVAILABLE.

GENERATION MAY BE CONDUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE UNITS EWO FLOW PLANS, OR EXTENDED TO ENCOMPASS THE ENTIRE TIME PERIOD AVAILABLE. AIRCRAFT REQUIRED TO SUPPORT AUTHORIZED FLYING AND MAINTENANCE COMMITMENTS NEED NOT BE GENERATED. THIS INCLUDES THE SEVEN TANKERS THAT DEPLOY IN SUPPORT OF 22BW AND 92SAW SEAGA AS OUTLINED IN PART II. GENERATION MUST BE COMPLETED NOT LATER THAN 0800 LOCAL, 25 OCT, YOUR STATION EXCEPT FOR AIRCRAFT LANDING TOO LATE TO BE GENERATED BY THIS TIME. THESE AIRCRAFT WILL BE GENERATED ASAP. THE AIRCRAFT REQUIRED FOR SNOW TIME 70-2 ECHO ON 28-29 OCT NEED NOT BE GENERATED UNTIL COMPLETION OF THAT MISSION.

2. AIRCRAFT WILL BE FULLY EWO CONFIGURED. THESE AIRCRAFT

WILL BE SCHEDULED, PREPARED AND ACCEPTED IN THE SAME MANNER AS ANY OTHER UNIT ALERT AIRCRAFT. AN AIRCREW WILL NOT BE ASSIGNED TO THE AIRCRAFT. CMT AND SEALED AUTHENTICATORS WILL NOT BE ON BOARD, AND THE COCKING CHECKLIST WILL NOT BE ACCOMPLISHED.

UNITS MAY, REPEAT MAY USE ALERT AIRCREWS AND GROUND CREWS TO PERFORM ACCEPTANCE PRE-FLIGHTS, SUBSEQUENT PRE-FLIGHTS AND SYSTEM OPERATIONS AS INDICATED IN PARA 3A THIS MESSAGE.

3. GROUND CREW PERSONNEL NEED NOT BE ASSIGNED TO THE OPERATED AIRCRAFT, AND CONSEQUENTLY MAY BE RELEASED FOR OTHER FLIGHT LINE DUTIES. ADEQUATE SUPERVISION WILL BE MAINTAINED OVER THESE WEAPON LOADED AIRCRAFT AND A CREW CHIEF WILL BE ASSIGNED PRIOR TO AIRCREW ARRIVAL IF THE SORTIE IS DIRECTED TO BE MANNED.

A. A DESIGNATED CREW CHIEF WILL PERFORM OR ASSIST IN THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULED ACTIVITY ON UNMANNED AIRCRAFT.

(1) A DAILY WALK-AROUND INSPECTION WILL BE ACCOMPLISHED TO CHECK FOR OBVIOUS EXTERNAL DEFECTS, AND FUEL, OIL AND HYD LEAKS.

(2) CONCURRENTLY WITH TIRE ROTATION (APPROX EVERY 3 DAYS) CHECK QUANTITY AND PRESSURE GAUGES IN THE HYDRAULIC, PNEUMATIC, AND OXYGEN SYSTEMS.

(3) THREE TIMES PER MONTH (7 TO 14 DAY INTERVAL) AIRCRAFT SYSTEMS WILL BE EXERCISED. THIS OPERATION WILL

INCLUDE ENGINE RUN CONDUCTED BY AVAILABLE FLIGHT CREWS. THE AIRCRAFT WILL NOT BE TAXIED FOR OTHER THAN TIRE ROTATION.

4. "GENERATED" AIRCRAFT WILL ALSO BE INCLUDED IN THE MONTHLY AND WEEKLY SCHEDULES AND WILL REMAIN WITHIN THE 7-42 DAY CRITERIA ESTABLISHED IN SACM 178-1, VOL I. SINCE THESE "GENERATED" AIRCRAFT ARE NOT COCKED, MAINTENANCE MAY BE PERFORMED AT ANY TIME (T.O. 11A-1-33 PERMITTING). FSAGA REQUIREMENTS ARE WAIVED FOR ALL ALERT AND "GENERATED" AIRCRAFT DURING THIS PERIOD.

A. WHILE IN "GENERATED" STATUS, THE AIRCRAFT WILL BELONG TO MAINTENANCE, AND ACCESS CONTROLLED BY A MAINTENANCE SAC FORM 380.

B. ALL CALENDAR INSPECTIONS AND ACTIONS (I.E. FUEL SUMP DRAINING, ETC.) WILL BE ACCOMPLISHED.

Johnson C. ~~INSPECTIONS WILL NOT BE ACCOMPLISHED~~ AND WATER MAY BE DOWNLOADED WHILE THE AIRCRAFT IS UNMANNED IF WEATHER CONDITIONS WOULD CREATE REQUIREMENTS FOR HEATING AND UPLOADED/DOWNLOADING. THESE ACTIONS MUST BE PRE-PLANNED FOR ACCOMPLISHMENT AS SOON AS POSSIBLE IF SORTIE MANNING IS DIRECTED.

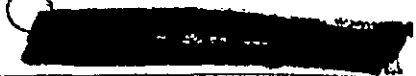

6. SECURITY REQUIREMENTS. NORMAL PRIORITY "A" SECURITY PROTECTION WILL BE PROVIDED. CLOSE-IN SECURITY WILL NOT BE REQUIRED FOR TANKER AIRCRAFT THAT DO NOT HAVE AIRCREWS ASSIGNED ^{OR} AND DO NOT ^{Have} POSSESS COMSECOR SEALED AUTHENTICATORS, ^{AB-Prod. Jm} WHEN POSSIBLE, ALL GENERATED AIRCRAFT SHOULD BE PARKED IN A SINGLE AREA. UNITS WILL REMAIN IN SECURITY OPTION IV AND PROVIDE SECURITY SUPPORT AS REQUIRED WITHOUT CHANGING THE SECURITY OPTION. UNITS WILL NOTIFY NAF (IGS) AND HQ SAC (IGS) WHEN SUPPORT REQUIRES USE OF A TWO-FLIGHT SYSTEM.

7. SACCS REPORTING INSTRUCTIONS WILL BE PROVIDED BY SEPARATE JOPREP JIFFY MESSAGE.

C. "I" HOUR IN THIS INSTANCE WILL NOT BE ACCOMPANIED BY DECLARATION OF DEFCON 3.

D. PRE "I" HOUR COORDINATION WITH CARF IS BEING EFFECTED BY THIS HEADQUARTERS.

3. WHILE THE IN-PLACE EIELSON TANKER TASK FORCE IS COMMITTED TO SEAGA SUPPORT, ALL RECONNAISSANCE REFUELING WILL BE PROVIDED BY KC-135 AIRCRAFT/CREWS DEPLOYED FROM 70 AREFS, LITTLE ROCK AFB, FOR THIS PERIOD.

A. BASED ON PROGRAMMED KC-135 SORTIE REQUIREMENTS, 70 AREFS WILL PROVIDE KC-135 AIRCRAFT/CREWS AS FOLLOWS:

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B. DURATION OF TDY WILL BE APPROXIMATELY TWO WEEKS, WITH SCHEDULE PROGRAMMED TO PROVIDE A STABLE FORCE OF 3 AIRCRAFT/3 CREWS. OVERLAP IS NECESSARY TO INCREASE RECON SUPPORT TANKERS TO 6 AIRCRAFT/6 CREWS FROM 3-9 NOV AND 14-16 NOV TO ACCOMMODATE PEAK RECON ACTIVITY.

C. AIRCRAFT WILL DEPLOY WITH KC-135Q MSK SPECIFIED IN ANNEX D, SACOPORD 60-70-13. KIT WILL REMAIN UNTIL THIS OPERATION IS TERMINATED AND WILL BE RETURNED ABOARD REDEPLOYING AIRCRAFT TO LITTLE ROCK AFB.

D. PERSONNEL REQUIREMENTS WILL BE PROVIDED BY SAC (DMZ) IN SEPARATE MESSAGE.

E. 6SW WILL DETERMINE DESIRED ROTATION TIMING SUBSEQUENT TO 26 OCT AND COORDINATE WITH 70 AREFS. ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE LAST HALF OF NOVEMBER WILL BE FURNISHED WHEN REQUIREMENTS ARE KNOWN.
