- IN A PRESS CONFERENCE IN TEHRAN FEBRUARY 6, THE HEAD OF THE AEOI, DR. AKBAR ETEMAD, SAID THAT IRAN HAS ABONDONED ANY PLANS FOR DOMESTIC NUCLEAR FUEL REPROCESSING FACILITY. INSTEAD, SAID ETEMAD, IRAN WAS NOW EXPLORING ALTERNATIVE REPROCESSING ARRANGEMENTS AT THE FILATERAL AND MULTILATERAL LEVEL. HE EXPRESSED SOME DOUBTS, HOWEVER, ON THE FEASIBILITY OF REGIONAL REPROCESSING CENTERS, CITING TECHNICAL, MANAGERIAL AND POLITICAL OBSTACLES.

FIELD, ETEMAD SAID THAT IRAN IS AWAITING AN INITIATIVE BY THE CCARTER ADMINISTRATION FOR A RESUMPTION IN TALKS ON "THE PURCHASE OF EIGHT U, S.-BUILT NUCLEAR REACTORS." ETEMAD SAID THAT TALKS WITH THE U,S. WERE DISCONTINUED LAST SUMMER PENDING U.S. ELECTIONS. HE SAID THAT "THE NEW ADMINISTRATION IS IN PLACE AND WE ARE AWAITING TO SEE WHAT THEIR APPROACH TO NUCLEAR SALES ABROAD IS."

- 3. WHILE ADDING THAT SAFEGUARDS MAY BE A NEW ELEMENT IN A NEW U.S. POLICY ON NUCLEAR SALES, ETEMAD SAID THAT NEVERTHELESS NO COUNTRY, OR GROUP OF COUNTRIES, "HAS A RIGHT TO DICTATE NUCLEAR POLICY TO ANOTHER." HE PROPOSED INSTEAD THAT THERE BE CLOSER DIALOGUE AMONG SUPPLIERS AND PURCHASERS OF NUCLEAR TECHNOLOGY.
- 4. ETEMAD SAID THAT CONSTRUCTION OF IRAN'S THIRD AND FOURTH NUCLEAR POWER STATIONS. EACH AT 900 MEGAWATIS, TO BE BUILT BY THE FRENCH, WILL BEGIN SOON AT A SITE 60 KILOMETERS SOUTH OF AHWAZ AT AN ESTIMATED COST OF \$2 BILLTON.

 HE SAID THE AEDI IS EXPLORING VARIOUS FINANCIAL ARRANGE-MENTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF ITS REMAINING REACTORS, INCLUDING DIL BARTER AND SUPPLIER CREDITS.
- 5. IN MEETING ON FEBRUARY 7 WITH ETEMAD (OR. ZUCKER/ORNL TEAM AND EMBASSY SCIENCE ATTACHE), HE ALSO EMPHASIZED THE NECESSITY FOR IRAN TO HAVE AN ASSURED LONG-TERM FUEL SUPPLY CONNECTED WITH ANY FUTURE NUCLEAR POWER REACTOR PURCHASES. ETEMAD ALSO SPOKE OF THE IMPORTANCE OF HAVING A "GLOBAL" VIEW OF NUCLEAR POWER, WHICH HE FELT WAS THUS FAR LACKING. ETEMAD CITEO ESPECIALLY THE NEED FOR MORE ENVIRONMENTAL CONSCIOUSNESS" IN THE CONTEXT OF THE OVERALL NUCLEAR FUEL CYCLE. MIKLOS
