

As we approach the reopening of the SALT talks, I wish to submit for your consideration some views as to the stance the United States should take.



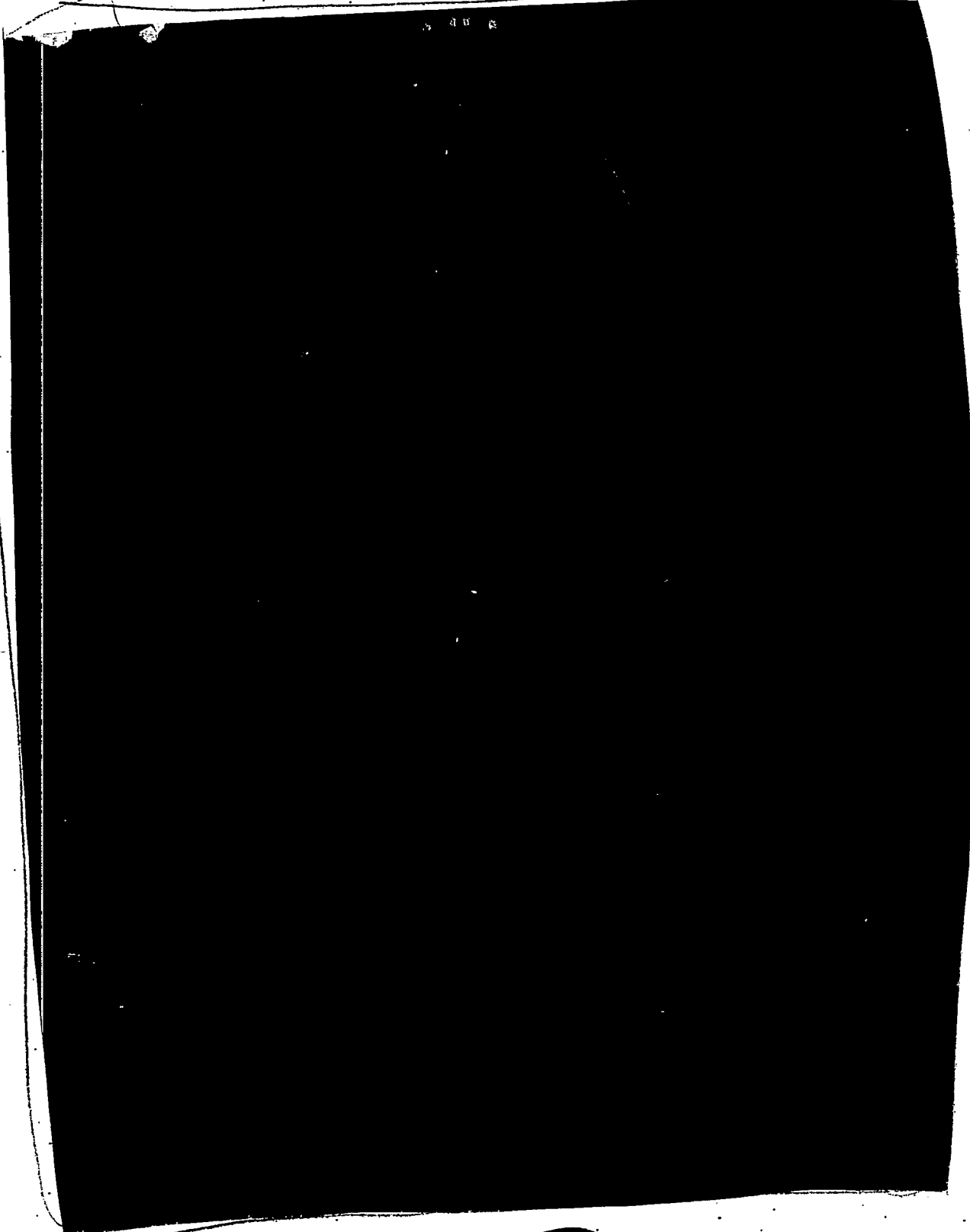

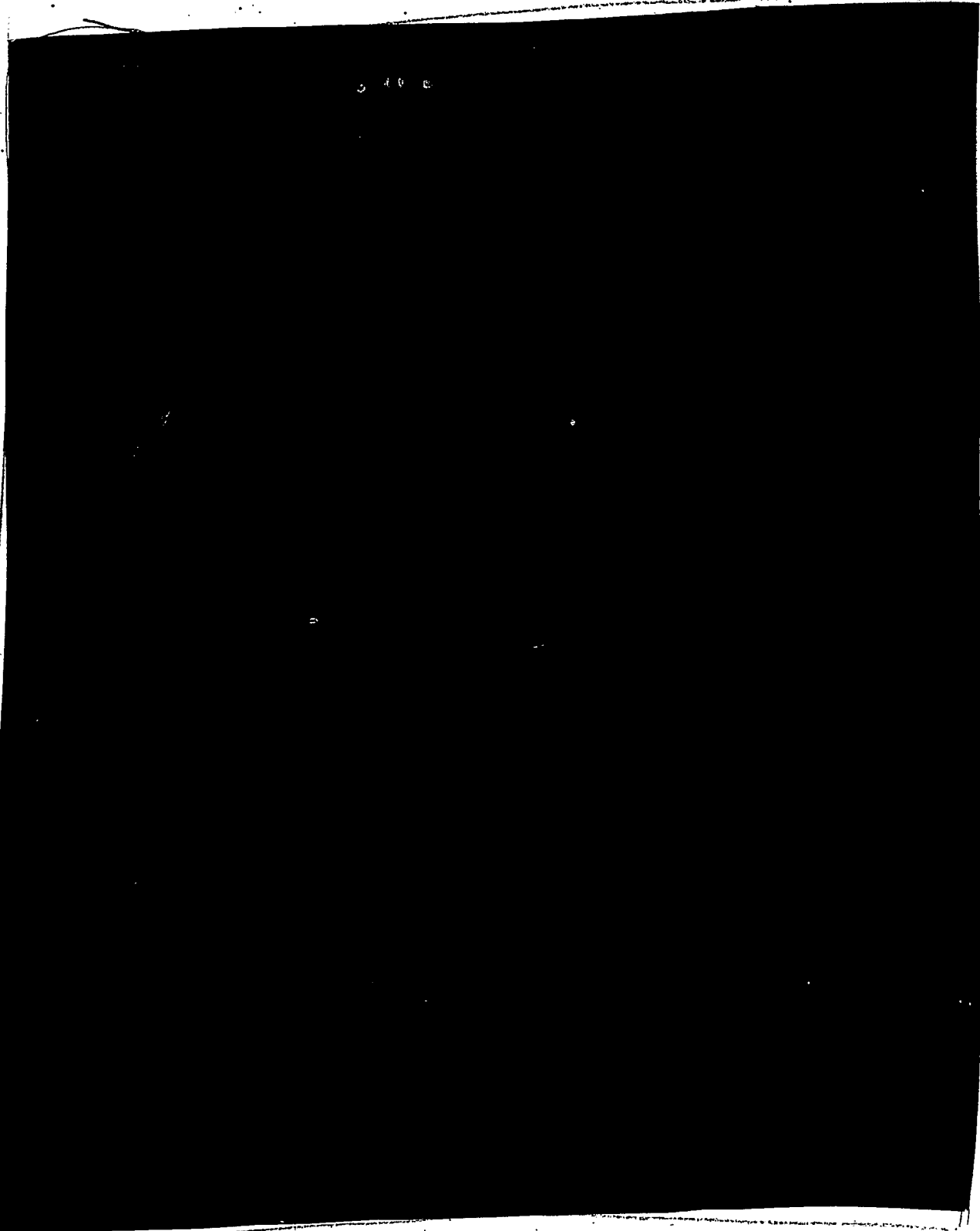

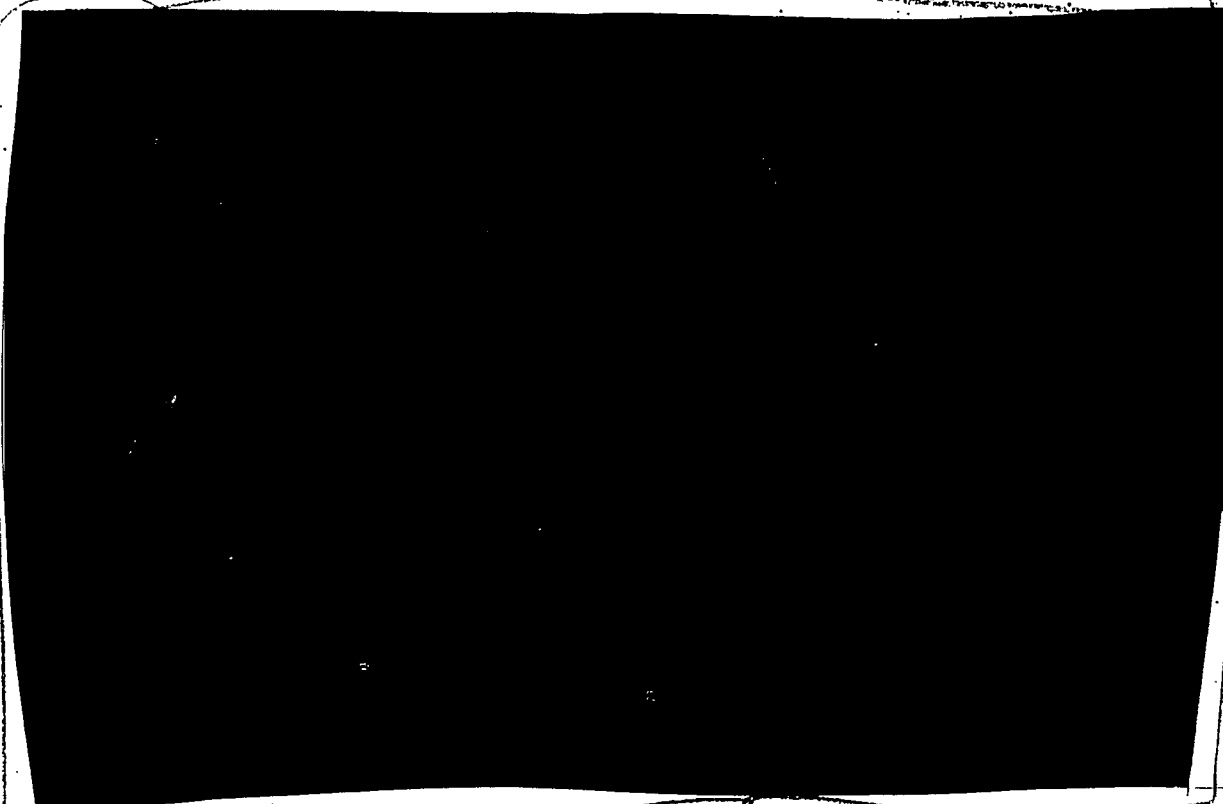
