DG COLE TOLD MISSION JAN 10 HE "HAD HEARD" BEN-GURION ON BEING QUERIED BY NEWSPAPER REPORTERS ABOUT POSSIBILITY ISRAEL SUBMITTING AGENCY SAFEGUARDS HAD REPLIED "HE KNEW ALL ABOUT AGENCY, BUT ISRAEL WOULD NOT SUBMIT TO SAFEGUARDS AND INSPECTION UNLESS BIG POWERS DID SAME." COLE SAID MEMBERS HIS STAFF HAD URGED HIM WRITE USREP SUGGESTING US USE GOOD OFFICES TO INDUCE ISRAEL SUBMIT SAFEGUARDS, BUT THAT HE HAD REFUSED ON GROUNDS SUCH LETTER WOULD BE "INAPPROPRIATE." COLE ADDED, HOWEVER, THAT HE INTENDED WRITE KEENAN, ISRAELI RESIDENT REP TO AGENCY, OFFERING AGENCY INSPECTION SERVICES "IF ISRAEL DESIRED."

ON MISSION'S INSISTENCE COLE AGREED NOT RPT NOT SEND SUCH LETTER UNTIL DEPT'S VIEWS SECURED.
